**Aarons Solomon** Private Oct 30<sup>th</sup>. 1861 3 Yrs. Enlisted Oct.31<sup>st</sup> 1861 Philadelphia aged 15 Mustered in Oct. 31st Oct.1861 Camp Observation Md.. Born 1847 England. Died Philadelphia Dec 12<sup>th</sup> 1902. Enlisted as drummer boy. He re-enlisted Sept. 9th Feb.1864 at Stevensburg Va. Buried in the Adath Jeshurun Cemetery Philadelphia.

**Anderson John Francis** Capt. Enlisted 19<sup>th</sup> Aug 1861 at Philadelphia as Capt. However all his records lost at West Peninsula Va. in 1862.

**Adams Jacob** Private April 2nd 1864 3 Yrs Discharged by Gen. Order July 1st 1865.

**Barnes James** Sergt. July 9th 1861 3 Yrs Absent sick at muster out.

**Bauers Michael** Private April 6th 1864 3 Yrs. Discharged by Gen. Order July 1st 1865.

**Beckmire Franklin** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs. Captured at Petersburg Va. June 22nd 1861.Held at Andersonville Ga. Absent sick at muster out.

**Beheny John** Private Sept.25th 1863 3 Yrs. Drafted. Captured at Petersburg June 22nd 1864. Imprisoned for a time in Andersonville Ga. Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865.Also served in the 71<sup>st</sup> Pa. Born 29<sup>th</sup> July 1832. Died March 3<sup>rd</sup> 1915 in Onset Pa. Buried Pleasant Hill Cemetery Green Point Lebanon Co. Pa.

**Bernheiser Frank** Private Aug.10th 1864 3 Yrs. Born Germany. Substitute. Served 10 months. Entered the DSV home Pa. 15.7.1891 aged 67. Had been living in Ohio. Had mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865.

**Bettinger Charles** Private April 10th. 1863 3 Yrs.Has very short military career. Deserted May 6th 1863 less than a month after joining and never returned.

**Boden John** John Boden initially enlisted in the 124<sup>th</sup> Infantry Regt Illinois as a private 10<sup>th</sup> Sept.1862. He was a resident of Kewanee Ill. He received a disability discharge from Co F of the Regt . filing for a pension Oct 12<sup>th</sup> 1862..For whatever reason he enlisted as a substitute in Co. B of the 69<sup>th</sup> Pa on 12<sup>th</sup> Aug 1864 at Frankfort Pa. aged 41. He remained in service until mustered out 1<sup>st</sup> July 1865. Wife named as Jane and child as James J. Boden. It is of interest to note that his widow filed for a pension from Iowa Feb 19<sup>th</sup> 1890. His son also filed for a pension from Iowa Nov.13<sup>th</sup> 1897.

**Boulton Bently (Bolton)** Private Aug.11th 1864 3 Yrs. Substitute. Wounded at Hatchers Run Va. Feb 5th 1865. Absent at muster out. (Photo).Buried St Peters Catholic Cemetery Reading Berks Co.Pa.Born Pa. 1819 Pa. Died Reading Berks

Co.Pa. Aug. 28<sup>th</sup> 1874.

**\* \* Boyle Hugh** (Co. ANTRIM) Private Jan 20<sup>th</sup> 1863 3 Yrs. Born Co. Antrim Ireland: Captured June 22<sup>nd</sup> 1864. Petersburg. Sent Andersonville prison then to Millen Ga. 11<sup>th</sup>. Nov 1864 Survived the incarceration. Absent at muster out.

**Boyle John** Private May 9<sup>th</sup> 1864 3 Yrs. Not on muster out roll.

**Bradley Samuel** Drafted soldier. Private Oct 19<sup>th</sup> 1863 3 Yrs From Philadelphia Enlisted 19<sup>th</sup> Oct. 1863 at Scranton Pa. from the 71<sup>st</sup> Pa. Mustered in 19<sup>th</sup> Oct 1863. aged 27. Captured June 22<sup>nd</sup>. 1864 Jerusalem Plank Road . Held at Andersonville Ga. Sick there and sent to Camp Parole Md. Mustered out with Co. July 1<sup>st</sup> 1865. Lived 18.12.1836-11.5.1907. Buried Mauch Chuck Cem. Jim Thorpe Carbon Co. Pa. Married man wife Harriet. Three children. Born 18.12.1836 Died May 11 1907.

**Bretz John** Private Oct. 19<sup>th</sup> 1863 3 Yrs. Captured June 22<sup>nd</sup> 1864 at Petersburg Va. Held at Andersonville Ga. Absent at muster out.

**\* \* Britt John C.** (Co. WESTMEATH) Sergt. Oct. 31<sup>st</sup> 1861 3 Yrs. Said to be born Co. Westmeath Ireland 1840-41; Enlisted Co. B 24<sup>th</sup> Regt. 1.5.1861 for three months. M.O. 10.8.1861. Was probably a Hibernian Greens militia man prior to enlisting. Between the 24<sup>th</sup> Regt and enlisting in the 69<sup>th</sup> he enlisted in Co. H 95<sup>th</sup> Regt. on 30<sup>th</sup> Sept 1861. He deserted 12<sup>th</sup> Oct. 1861 in order to enlist in the 69<sup>th</sup> 31<sup>st</sup> Oct. 1861 Co. B. Captured near Petersburg Va June 22<sup>nd</sup> 1864 and source states that he was held for a period at Libby Prison Va. and that he carved his initial JB on a wall there. Prom. 1<sup>st</sup> Sergt. May 22<sup>nd</sup> 1865. Mustered out with Co. July 11<sup>th</sup> 1865 at Balls Cross Va. He later married Sarah McShea widow of 1<sup>st</sup> Sergt Co. H 69<sup>th</sup> who was killed at Gettysburg on 20.1.1868. James died in Philadelphia 15.4.1876. Coachmaker by trade. Height 5ft 7 1/2". Sandy hair blue eyes. No known grave identified ( as at 12.11.2010)

**Brown Cornelius (Neal)** Private Oct. 31<sup>st</sup> 1861 3 Yrs. Discharged on Surgeons Cert. Feb. 11<sup>th</sup> 1863. Was recorded as living in a Philadelphia almshouse in the census of 1890 and in a state of senility.

**Burchill John** Private Aug. 8<sup>th</sup> 1864 3 Yrs. Substitute. Mustered out with Co. July 1<sup>st</sup> 1865.

**Burns William J** Sergt. Sept 1<sup>st</sup> 1861 3 Yrs. Mustered out Sept. 6<sup>th</sup> 1864 Expiration of term

**Butterworth James** Private Oct. 31<sup>st</sup> 1861 3 Yrs. Deserted Sept 1<sup>st</sup> 1862.

**\* \* Cain John (Kane or O'Kane)** (Co. DERRY) Private Oct. 31<sup>st</sup> 1861 3 Yrs. Born Co. Derry Ireland 1833. Fought at Gettysburg. Fought at the wall in front of the clump of trees. Discharged Dec. 30<sup>th</sup> for wounds received at Cold Harbour Va. June 5<sup>th</sup> 1864. Had enlisted at Philadelphia. He had been a watchmaker by trade. Lived at a time 65 Pine St Jersey City. Other sources state profession was boatman. Had first wife Bridgid before the war who died 1858. Married Mary after the war, John died March 1<sup>st</sup> 1888 and is buried in the Holy Name cemetery Jersey City Hudson Co. N.J. Buried 6<sup>th</sup> March as John Kane.

**Callahan P 2<sup>nd</sup>** Private Oct 31<sup>st</sup> 1861 3 Yrs. Discharged on Surgeons Cert. April 16<sup>th</sup> 1863.

**\* \* Callahan P. 1<sup>st</sup>.** (Co. DONEGAL) Private Oct. 31<sup>st</sup> 1861 3 Yrs Born Co. Donegal Ireland: Deserted July 11<sup>th</sup> 1862. at Harrisons Landing Va.

**Callahan P. 3<sup>rd</sup>** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs. Deserted July 11th 1862.

**\*\* Campbell George** (Co. DERRY) Private Oct.17th 1861 3 Yrs. Born Co. Derry Ireland: Fought at Gettysburg. Buried Mount Moriah Cemetery Philadelphia Jan. 4th 1863.(Burial record). Born 1816 Died 25.12.1873.

**Campbell George** Private Oct.21st 1861 3 Yrs Transferred to Vet. Res. Corps. Nov. 16th 1863.

**\*\* Campbell Murdock** (Co. CLARE) Lieut. April 30th 1861 3 Yrs. Born Co. Clare Ireland circa 1830: An original member of Co. B 24th Regt. Fought at Gettysburg July 1863. Prom. Sergt. Major Nov. 5th 1863. Later to Lieut. Badly wounded at Spotsylvania Court House Va May 12th 1864. Discharged on Surgeons Cert. Oct. 27th 1864. Found his way west to California shortly after the war ended. His grave and that of his wife Hannah and some family members found in the "Old" Mission graveyard of Santa Cruz Dec. 2007. See website information and image of his grave. He died in 1890. Listed as a tailor in one of the local trade journals. Was member of the GAR organisation in Cal. W. H. L. Wallace Post No. 32.

**Carpenter Albert** Private July 14th 1861 3 Yrs. Absent sick at muster out. Born Roxborough Pa.1841.Died Dec 10 1903 Philadelphia. A painter by trade. Lived 1711 N. 20<sup>th</sup> St Philadelphia. Buried in Montrose Cemetery Upper Derby Philadelphia Pa.

**Carr Joseph** Private April 5th 1864 3 Yrs. Discharged by Gen. Order July 1st 1865.M.I. Philadelphia 5.4.1864 aged 21 florid complexion, height 5ft 5ins blue eyes red hair. From New York. Living at Le High Co. Pa. Painter by trade. Some rolls show name as Car

**Carvin Thomas** Private May 21st 1861 3 Yrs. Wounded at Spotsylvania Court House May 12th 1864. Mustered out Jan 13th 1865 at expiration of term.

**Casey John** Private Oct 31st 1861 3 Yrs. Deserted Oct.16th 1862.

**Cassidy James** Private April 4th 1864 3 Yrs. Enrolled Philadelphia 4.4.1864 aged 19 fair complexion 5ft.. 6ins. blue eyes chestnut hair and was a waterman by trade. Discharged by Gen. Order July 1st 1865.

**### Cassidy Michael** Enrolled Philadelphia 9.9.1861.Mustered in 11.9.1861 as 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieut. 1st Lieut. Sept.11th 1861 3 Yrs.Prom. from 2nd Lieut. to Lieut. May 1st 1863. Discharged May 15th 1863. Later died from wounds received at Antietam. Buried "Old" St. Michaels cemetery Philadelphia. No marker Feb. 2017.

**Cassidy Patrick** + Private Oct. 31st 1861 3 Yrs. Died at Washington D.C Jan. 4th 1862. Buried at the Military Asylum Cemetery Wash. D.C. ( Burial record Jan. 4th. 1863). Plot H-3605. Had contracted typhoid fever. Enlisted aged 39 in Philadelphia. Left a widow Susan who died in 1891. Lived S. 10th. St. Philadelphia.

**Christie Thomas** Private Oct.31st 1863 3 Yrs. Wounded at Fredericksburg Va Dec.13th 1862.Mustered out Dec.30th 1864.Born England. 1839 Wounded Fredericksburg Dec 13<sup>th</sup> 1862. Survived the war. Died in Philadelphia June 30<sup>th</sup> 1897 from pneumonia aged 58 Did not marry. Obit in P.I. July 4<sup>th</sup> 1897. Lost an arm during his service. Ended his life at Hampton Old Soldiers Home. Buried Old

Cathedral Cemetery Philadelphia. Plot E-2-34.@ M.

**Clark Edward** Private April 14th 1864 3 Yrs. Not on muster out roll. Buried Cold Harbour Cem. Cold Harbour Va.

**Clopp John E** - M.O.H Private Feb.25th 1864 3 Yrs. Born Philadelphia 1845 Charles started off life as a soldier in Co F of the 71st Pa. Inf. He was transferred to the 69th Pa. 12.6.1864. until discharged on Surgeons Cert. Mar. 24th 1865. Buried Lawnview Cemetery Rockledge Mont Co. Pa. Glenwood Plot Section Row 50 Grave 35. It is unlikely that he served but was simply one of those transferred to the 69<sup>th</sup>.Pa from the 71<sup>st</sup> at the end of the war. However some of those who were transferred earlier or had longer enlistment periods did actually carry out service as fighting soldiers. Received M.O.H. for "Capturing of flag of the 9<sup>th</sup> Va Inf. wrestling it from the colour bearer".

**Collins Charles** Private April 18th 1864 3 Yrs. Not on muster out roll.

**Colvin Clifton** Substitute soldier. Born 1845 Died 1908. Enlisted 22<sup>nd</sup> June 1864. Mustered out 1<sup>st</sup> July 1865. Buried with wife Elizabeth. Buried Nicholson Cemetery Wyoming Co. Pa.

**Connors John** Private April 16th 1864 3 Yrs. Not on muster out roll

**Cook Joseph {Crook}** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs. Aged 28. Captured Petersburg Va. June 22nd 1864.Held Andersonville Ga. Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865.Born 1834 Philadelphia. Died Feb 7<sup>th</sup> 1914 Philadelphia. Buried Northwood Cemetery Philadelphia. Assigned initially to Brigade H.Q.as a cook. A gardener by trade dark complexion, blue eyes 5ft 4ins tall. Had re-enlisted at Stevensburg Pa,

**### Coyne Michael** Major Aug.19th 1861 3 Yrs. Killed at Antietam Md. Sept. 17th 1862. Had been a barman in Major Duffy's hotel In Philadelphia. Died Sept 30<sup>th</sup> 1862 Frederick Frederick Co. Maryland. Died from gunshot wound received at the battle of Antietam. Buried Old Cathedral Cemetery Philadelphia. Plot F-6-18-M. @ M.

**Delihunt Patrick** Private Sept.23rd 1863 3 Yrs. Drafted. Captured June 22nd 1864 Absent at muster out.

**Devoy James** Private April 5th 1864 3 Yrs. Discharged by Gen. Order July 1st 1865.

**Dickson James** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs. Discharged on Surgeons Cert. Nov. 15th 1862.

**Donly John** Private April 6th 1864 3 Yrs. Dropped from rolls May 1st 1865.

**### Donnelly Edward** Private May 9th 1864 3 Yrs Born Ireland. Enlisted 9th May 1864 in Philadelphia and mustered in the same day. From Lancaster Co. A small man about 5' 5" aged 29 blue eyes with a florid complexion. A labourer by trade. Discharged by Gen. Order July 1st 1865. Not on muster out roll.

**\* \* Dooley James** (Co. LAOIS) Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs. Discharged on Surgeons Cert. Feb.2nd 1863. Born Co. Laois.

**Dooley James** Private April 2nd 1864 3 Yrs. Discharged by Gen. Order July 1st 1864.

**\* \* Dorrington Charles** (Co. DUBLIN)) Enlisted Oct 31<sup>st</sup> 1861 3 yrs Discharged June 30<sup>th</sup> 1863 .Died 26<sup>th</sup> Oct. 1899. Buried Dayton National Cemetery Dayton. Mont. Co. Ohio. From Co Dublin

**Dorrington** Corp. Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs. Prom Corp.Jan.1st 1865.Mustered out with Co. July 14th 1865.

\* \* **Dorrington James (Co. DUBLIN)** Sergt. Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs. Born Co. Dublin Ireland: Deserted Sept.1st 1862. Had a record of desertion and was fined \$30 at one stage.

\* \* **Dougan (Dugan) Daniel** (Co. DONEGAL) Private Oct.31st 1864 3 Yrs. Aged 28. Born Co. Donegal Ireland: Wounded at Spotsylvania Court House Va. May 12th 1864.Discharged Sept. 9th 1864 at expiration of time. Fair hair,blue eyes air complexion height 5ft 8 1/2 ins. Labourer. Initially in the 24<sup>th</sup> Reg. 3 month enlistment.

**Dougherty Andrew D** Private Oct.31st.1861 3 Yrs enlisted aged 32. Discharged Feb 22nd 1863 for wounds received at Fredericksburg Va Dec.13th 1862.Certificate of Discharge 22.2 1865.

**Dougherty Edward** Private April 2nd 1864 3 Yrs Enrolled Philadelphia aged 21 Mustered in 2.4.1864 Fair complexion height 5ft 7in hazel eyes hair chestnut bricklayer by profession . Born in Pittsburg Pa. From in Mont. Co. Discharged by Gen.Order July 1st 1865.

\* \* **Dougherty (Doherty) Eneas** (Co. DONEGAL) Enrolled 3 yrs. 30.8.1861 at Philadelphia. **M.I. as** 1<sup>st</sup> Lieut. Sept 11th 1861 3Yrs. A.D.C to Gen. Joshua Owen. A clerk by profession and at a time recording secretary of the Wolf Tone Fenian Brotherhood Philadelphia. Died aged 47 Philadelphia 19th Sept 1889 and buried Old Cathedral Cemetery 23rd Sept. 1889. Grave Lot 1-3-61 later (10.10.1894) in plot IMJN-1. Lived at 1945 Christian St. Philadelphia. A single man. Died of pneumonia and kidney disease. Discharged 1.4.1863 health problems. He probably spelt his name as Doherty the most common spelling in Donegal. He was apparently from Carndonagh in that county. Mentioned in dispatches by General Owen. Initially served in the 24<sup>th</sup> Pa.

**Duffy John** Private May 9th 1864 3 Yrs Discharged by Gen. Order July 1st 1865.

**Dunn John** Private April 13th 1864 3 Yrs. Not on muster out roll.

\* \* **Early Peter** (Co. TYRONE) Private Oct. 31st 1861 3 Yrs. Discharged Feb.7th 1863 for wounds received at Antietam Md. Sept.1 7th 1862.Born Co Tyrone.

**Eyrie William** Private July 14th 1861 3 Yrs. Absent sick at muster out.

### **Faddin Arthur (McFadden)** Corp Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs. Born Ireland. Composed the song ""Col. Owens Gallant Irish Volunteers" based on the tune "Irish Volunteers".Wounded June 30th 1862 at. Harrisons Landing. Died July 27th 1862. Also known as Arthur Faddin and Arthur Haggin. His obituary names him as Arthur Faddin. Buried Old Cathedral Cemetery Philadelphia Section E. Range 2 Grave 40.

**Faddin Arthur M** Private Oct. 31st. 1861 3 yrs See entry on Arthur McFadden

**Farley John** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs.Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865.

\* \* **Farrell Nicholas** (Co. LOUTH) Sergt. Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs. Born Co. Louth Ireland: Prom. from Corp. May 1st 1863. Wounded at Fredericksburg Va. Dec.13th 1862 at Gettysburg 3rd July 1863 at The Wilderness Va May 6th 1864. Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865. Married after the war in Newark N.J. and raised a family of seven. Plagued by poor health mainly due to war wounds. He died 5th. Nov 1893 and is buried in the Holy Sepulchre Cemetery East Orange N.J. Lived 13 Van Buren

St. Newark N.J. buried after 8.30 Mass on Nov. 7th 1893 St James Church. Member of Philip Sheridan GAR post 110.

**Fenn George** Private Aug. 16th 1862 3 Yrs. Transferred to 12th Regt N.J.Vols.Date unknown.

**\*\* Fitzpatrick Mark (Michael?) (Co. GALWAY)** Private enrolled 26<sup>th</sup> Aug and mustered in 31<sup>st</sup> Oct 1861 at Camp Observation Md. fot 3 Yrs. Born Co Galway Ireland: Fought at Gettysburg. Killed at Deep Bottom Va Aug. 24th 1864.A blacksmith by trade aged 36 5ft 8ins tall grey eyes auburn hair.

**### Flood Hugh** 1st Lieut. Enrolled 1<sup>st</sup> Sept 1861 at Philadelphia for 3 Yrs. Enrolled 31<sup>st</sup> Oct. 1861 at Camp Observation Md. Discharged March 27th 1863 for wounds received at Fredericksburg Va. Dec.13th 1862. Died aged 57 Buried in family plot Holy Cross Cemetery Philadelphia. Plot Section 3 Range 9 Lot 48 Grave 28.

**Flynn Patrick** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Deserted Jan 1st. 1862 but returned July 20th 1862.Wounded at Fredericksburg Dec.13 th 1862. Something of a maverick he initially was in Co. B. 24<sup>th</sup> Pa. Inf, then Co.B 69<sup>th</sup> Pa. then in Co. B 115<sup>th</sup> Pa Inf, then Co F 1<sup>st</sup> Mass Heavy Art. Used the alias name William Godfrey at a time. Absent at muster out.

**Francisco John** Private April 6th 1864 3 Yrs Not on muster out roll.

**### Furey Thomas** Capt. Sept.11th 1861 3 Yrs. Born Ireland: Resigned Sept 25th.1862. Had poor relations with O'Kane and other officers. Owens recommended his resignation and signed it due to his incompetence particularly at Antietam.The truth of we shall never know. Attend Col. Dennis O'Kane's funeral. Thomas died from influenza 19th March 1912 aged 84. He had been in poor health for some 10 years. Lived as a widower. Father was Mathias Furey also born Ireland. Thomas buried in the old Cathedral Cemetery 29th March 1912. Funeral from his home at 1316 Redfield St. Philadelphia.

**### Gallagher Hugh** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs. Discharged on Surgeons Cert. Sept 15th 1862. Died 11.4.1891 Philadelphia. Buried St Denis Cemetery Haverton Del Co. Pa (Cobbs Creek).Had also served in the 24<sup>th</sup> Pa. Inf. Born 1838 Ireland. From the name probably Co. Donegal. Buried Saint Denis Cemetery Havetown Del. Co. Pa.

**Gallagher John** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs. Killed at Charles City Cross roads June 30th 1862.

**\*\* Gallagher Timothy** (Co. DONEGAL) Private 28th Nov. 1861 3 Yrs. Born Co. Donegal Ireland: Killed Gettysburg.2nd. July 1863. He was 27 years old. He is buried in the National Cemetery Gettysburg Section C. Grave 45.

**Gangawere Reuben** Private Sept.24th 1863 3 Yrs, Drafted. Transferred to V.R.C. Feb. 2nd 1862

**Garron Francis** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs. Dropped from rolls May 1st 1865

**Geiger John** Private Sept. 24th 1863 3 Yrs Drafted. Captured June 22.1864.Absent at muster out.

**\*\* Gibbons Bernard** (Co. DERRY) Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Born Co. Derry Ireland; Deserted June 8th 1862

**Gibson Francis** Private Sept 24th 1863 3 Yrs. Drafted Born 1841 in Patterson

Pa. Enlisted in Co. E of the 71<sup>st</sup> Pa Inf. 27.9 1863. Captured June 22nd 1864 Weldon Road. Served time in both Old Libby and Andersonville prison camps. Died at Fort Wayne Allen Co. Ind. March 2<sup>nd</sup>. 1919. Discharged by Gen. Order June 2nd 1865. Lived many years in Fort Wayne Ind. Was a member of Lawton Wayne GAR post. Was married man. Wife Fannie M. Gibson. Buried in the Lindenwood Cemetery Fort Wayne Allen Co. Ind. Plot R Lot 157. He was with others transferred 12<sup>th</sup> June 1864 to Co. B of the 69<sup>th</sup> Pa.

**Gillen George** Sergt. Aug. 26th 1861 3 Yrs. Killed Baileys Cross Roads Va. Sept. 29th 1861. Munsons Hill area. George would be the first soldier of the 69th to be killed in the actual war. Mary his wife in her pension application states that she had lived in Scotland prior to Philadelphia. Both she and George may well have been Scots. She had four children living with her by 1862. By 1862 she had been in Philadelphia 14 years and also George was aged 45 as was she.

Yeadon Pa. In position Section 13 range 11 12 13 .No listings available of the names of those who actually “ made” the transfer. It is assumed that Hagan was actually transferred.. He was born in Ireland.. Wife Ellen Hagen died June 1889 and son George Oct 1908 Ellen buried New Cat cemetery and George in the Holy Cross cemetery. His return of death notes him as being a sailor by profession. @?.

He had enlisted 14th August 1862 in Philadelphia. Andrew was a small man 5ft 4 inches tall had blue eyes brown hair and a sandy complexion. His enlistment sheet was signed by Lieut Joseph W. Sunderland of the 72nd Regt. In a

well researched book by a descendant McGuckin family member it states that Andrews body was brought back from a shallow grave at Gettysburg where he had been killed and brought it back to Phoenixville. This would be a substantial journey in such times. He was supposed to be the only soldier of Co. B buried at Gettysburg. The Philadelphia Public Ledger reported Andrews death on July 13th 1863 and that he was buried from his mothers house to St. Marys Cemetery in Phoenixville. Note that the name McGuckin has varient spelling even to this day in Co. Derry as McGuckin, McGucken etc etc. His name is spelt as McGurkin on his headstone at St. Marys died July 1st 1863. The date should be July 3rd. See Website. Brother to Edward below.

A May 1st 1863.Captured at Petersburg June 22nd 1864. Promoted Capt June 1st. 1865. Commissioned Major June 16th 1865. Not mustered. Missed Gettysburg due to being absent with gun shot. Later was court-martialled. Not related to John McHugh of Co. A. Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865Buried Holy Cross cemetery buried Section 3 Range 3 Lot 19. Grave 4 @

**### McIlvane John** Born Ireland. 1st Lieut. Sept. 11th 1861 3 Yrs. Promoted from Corp. to 2nd Lieut May 1st 1863 to 1st Lieut. Oct 23rd 1863. Fought and was slightly wounded Gettysburg. Later court-martialled and dismissed Apparently had a reputation of favouritism, fixing, and general behaviour "not conducive to the behaviour of an officer and a gentleman". A document exists that his wife had him judged insane prior to 1892 and she was appointed by the court as his legal guardian. His pension papers shows that he was living at the Philadelphia Almshouse (insane section) at least by July 11<sup>th</sup> 1889. He subsequently died there July 15<sup>th</sup> 1892 from dysentery. Attended Col. Dennis O'Kanes funeral in Philadelphia.

He had been dismissed from service Feb.10th 1865. Was a shoemaker by trade. Initially buried in the Mount Zion Church Ground Philadelphia Note this cemetery later became defunct and some but not all remains removed to Arlington?. He had initially been in Co H of the 24<sup>th</sup> Regt. At his death living in 4<sup>th</sup> Ward 129 Almona St.

**\*\* McKiernan John** (Co. ANTRIM) Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Born Co. Antrim Ireland. Enlisted 2.9.1861 Philadelphia. Mustered in Camp Observation Md. 31.10.1861. Aged 23. Was a boatman by trade. Deserted July 11th 1862. Harrisons Landing Va.

**McKimmon James** Private April 2nd 1864 3 Yrs. Discharged by Gen.Order July 1st 1865.

**McMahan** Private April 13th 1864 3 Yrs. Discharged by Gen. Order July 1st 1865.

**McManus James** Private Jan 17th 1865 3 Yrs. Enlisted 17<sup>th</sup>Jan.1865 Norristown and mustered in same day. Aged 27.Height 5' 10",florid com complexion, blue eyes,

brown hair. Clerk. Born Newcastle Del. Resided Hamilton Pa. Not on muster out roll. Buried Gettysburg. section D. Grave 10.

**\*\* McNamara John** (Co. Cork ) Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs. Joined the 69th aged 27 Aug. 30th 1861 as Corp and reduced to prvte.11th Aug. 1861. Buried Philadelphia Old Cath. Cemetery Oct. 14th 1862. Killed at Antietam Sept 17th 1862. See obit listing. Dated 14.10.1862. Brother to Matthew below. John had married Ellen on March 5<sup>th</sup> 1854 and had three children Daniel John and Mary. Johns wife applied for a pension on Nov.27<sup>th</sup> 1862 for her and family.. Ellen re-married in 1867 Christopher Sheehan and lost her pension but went on to file for a guardian pension for her children.

**\*\* McNamara Matthew** (Co. Cork) Private Enlisted aged 39 on Oct. 31st 1861 at Philadelphia 3 Yrs Transferred to Vet Res. Corps June 15th 1864. Discharged by Gen Order. June 29th 1865. Fought with brother John at Antietam where John was killed. He fought on with the 69<sup>th</sup> until he got sick April 23<sup>rd</sup> 1863 at Potomac Creek Va.He was sent to a convalescence home in Va. On Jan 15<sup>th</sup> 1864 Matthew was transferred to the V.R.C. in Wash D.C. Before the war he lived at Front and Pine St. Philadelphia.

**McNeil John** Private Jan.30th 1865 3 Yrs. Drafter Captured at Petersburg June 22nd 1864 Held prisoner Andersonville Ga. Survived and was .mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865. Brother to John above.

**\*\* McNichol Daniel** (Co. DERRY) Sergt. Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Born Co. Derry Ireland: Fought at Gettysburg. Deserted April 20th 1864. Died aged 50 21<sup>st</sup> Nov 1888 aged 50.Buried in the Old Cathedral Cemetery Philadelphia 23<sup>rd</sup> Nov 1888. Plot U-5-27. Lived with wife Annie at the rear of 1311 Carlton St. Philadelphia. Noted as having deserted after having signed up again for re-enlistment where he got some of the bonus money and a 30 days furlough.. His name was later scratched off the Gettysburg plaque and his widow was subsequently denied a pension.. He and wife Anne lived at 1311 Carlton St. Philly. She was as a widow still living there in the 1893 Philly St directory. The name common in parts of Co. Derry to this day especially Limavady, Ballykelly Dungiven area. Buied in the Old Cathedral Cemetery Philadelphia. Plot U-5-27.@/

**### McShea James F.** Sergt. Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Born Ireland: Killed at Gettysburg July 3rd 1863 buried in National Cem. Gettysburg. Pa section. C-44. His widow Sarah subsequently married 1st Sergt John Britt C. B. in 1868.

**\*\* McSorley Matthew** (Co. TYRONE) Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Born Co Tyrone Ireland probably Beragh area. Said to have married a Jane Kelly of Gortfin in 1848 at Carrickmore chapple. Died Dec.14th of wounds received at Fredericksburg Dec. 13th 1862. Buried in mass grave of Union soldiers in the Fredericksburg Va area. Came to Philadelphia 1850. Jane died young 1860 prior to the Civil War. Children Patrick and Mary Jane raised by Jane's brother Patrick. They lived in St Michael's parish and Jane buried there.

**Meily Luke** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs. Born 1839. Wounded on the hand at Gettysburg 3rd July 1863. He was sent on July 7<sup>th</sup> from hospital Gettysburg to hospital Philadelphia and shortly afterwards walked out of the hospital and was then classified as a deserter. He never returned and was in later years refused a pension

twice because of this charge. Absent in muster out.. He initially lived in Philadelphia but by 1895 was living at 4215 5<sup>th</sup> Ave Rock Island Ill. It is assumed that he died in Rock Island but no connections found to date.

**Merrylees James** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs. Wounded at Gettysburg July 3rd 1863. Absent at muster out. Born Philadelphia 1846 and sadly died May 4<sup>th</sup>1880 Philadelphia from laudanum overdose. Death cert states suicide. A married man. Buried Mount Moriah Cemetery Philadelphia. Born in Vermont. Wife Sarah H. Merrylees lived 1842 until 1880. Wife Sarah H lived 1849-1938 Did aged 89.

**Monahan Michael** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs. Discharged on Surgeons Cert. Nov.29th 1862.

**Moore Peter** Private April 4th 1864 3 Yrs. Not on muster out roll.

**\*\* Morrow Henry** (Co. DUBLIN).Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Born Co. Dublin Ireland: Had been a prisoner at Richmond later exchanged. Wounded at Gettysburg. Deserted. Returned. Wounded and captured at Reams Station 25th Aug. 1864 Held at Andersonville Ga. Survived incarceration. Sick at muster out.

**Moyer Alex (Andrew?)** Private Aug 19th 1861 3 Yrs Captured at Petersburg June 22nd 1864.reported to have died at Andersonville Ga July 1st 1864.but not buried there. McDermott lists him as dieing Andersonville.

**Mullin Joshua** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs. Died Camp Observation Jan.9th 1862.

**Murphy Patrick** Private April 1st 1864 3 Yrs. Wounded at Spotsylvania Court House May 9th 1864. Absent at muster out.

**Murphy Patrick** Sergt. Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs. Discharged Feb.20th 1863.for wounds received at Fredericksburg. Dec 13th 1862.

**Murray Edward** Private April 2nd 1864 3 Yrs Discharged by Gen. Orders July 1st 1865.

**\*\* Murray James** (Co. WESTMEATH) .Private Sept.27th 1862 3 Yrs. Born Co. Westmeath Ireland: Wounded at Fredericksburg Dec.13th 1862.Lost an arm and also partially deafened. Would later die in rail accident caused by his war wounds and deafness. Absent at muster out.

**O'Brien Patrick** Private Oct. 31st 1861 3 Yrs Discharged March 16th 1863 for wounds received at Antietam Sept.17th 1862. Died Sept 24<sup>th</sup> 1863. Buried Old Cathedral Cemetery Philadelphia. Plot C.6,43.+.

**\*\*O'Neill James** (Co. DERRY) Private Enrolled 26<sup>th</sup> Aug 1861 3 Yrs Born Co. Derry. Killed at Gettysburg July 2nd 1863. Buried in National Cemetery Gettysburg. Pa Section C-41. He had enlisted Philadelphia Oct. 31st. 1861 aged 40. Also had served in the 24th Pa. Was sick for period prior to Gettysburg starting 9<sup>th</sup> Sept.1861.

**O'Rourke James** Private April 4th 1864 3 Yrs. Discharged by Gen. Order. July 1st 1865.

**O'Rourke John** Private April 30th 1865.captured at Gettysburg June 22nd 1864.Absent at muster out. 3 Yrs Captured at Petersburg Va. .June 22nd 1864. Held Andersonville. Survived .Absent at muster out.

**Ploss John W.** Private Sept.1st 1861 3 Yrs. Mustered out Sept.7th 1864 expiration of term. Died 28.1.1902. Buried Cypress National Cemetery Brooklyn Kings Co. New York. Plot 5959. Originally in the 71st Pa he was transferred to the 69th to

finish his time. John enlisted in New York city along with his older brother William a tailor. John was initially a window and sash maker. After the war he worked as a dock builder. He married Isabella and they had three children. He had enlisted and mustered in at N.Y.C 7.9.1861. Fought at Gettysburg.

**Quigley Philip** Private Sept.26th 1863 3 Yrs.Captured by Confederates. at Petersburg Va. Held at Andersonville Ga. Sent Millen Ga 31st. Oct. 1864.Survived this incarceration but died at Camp Parole Md. Dec.5th 1864. Buried Annapolis National Cemetery Annapolis Md. Section B Site 475 Marker photo.

**Quinn James** Private Enlisted Oct.31st 1861 for 3 Yrs aged 32 Dishonourably discharged July 3rd 1862.

\* \* **Regan John** (Co. ROSCOMMON) Corp Oct.31st. 1861 3 yrs. Born Co. Roscommon Ireland: Wounded at Antietam Sept. 17th 1862 Prom to Corp. Jan 1st 1865.Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865.

**Riley Terrence** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs. Died at Philadelphia Oct.9th 1862 aged 32 of wounds received at Antietam Sept.17th 1862.Buried in the Old Cathedral Cem. Philadelphia.

**Riley Charles** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Discharged on Surgeons Cert Nov. 5th 1862

**Riordon Thomas** Enlisted aged 23 as Sergt Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs. Fought in all engagements up to May 1863 but deserted in Philadelphia. in June 6th 1863. Had enrolled Philadelphia 18<sup>th</sup> Sept 1861 aged 23 as Corp. Dark complexion, 5ft 8ins hazel eyes dark hair. Was from Boston Ma. and had been a sailor. Dark complexion 5ft 8 ins tall hazel eyes dark hair dark complexion. Deserted 6<sup>th</sup> June 1863 while on furlough. He had taken his rifle and leathers home before he deserted. From Boston Mass. Had been a sailor. Had served in the 24<sup>th</sup> Pa.

**Robinson Bernard** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs. Deserted June 8th. Returned July 20th Deserted again (Year unknown)

**Rodgers Dennis** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs.He was aged 27. Discharged on surgeons Cert. Aug.27th 1862. Re-enlisted April 1864. Discharged 5.6.1864 for wounds received at The Wilderness Va. May 6th 1864. Buried in National cemetery Dayton Ohio. Plot G-1-13. Died 11-11-1887 . He had been dismissed 27<sup>th</sup> Aug 1862 but had re-joined

**Rogers George** Private Jan 1 2th 1865 3 Yrs Not on muster out roll.

**Rowe Aaron** Sergt. Sept. 1st 1862 3 Yrs. Wounded at Mine Run Va Nov.27th 1863.Prom. from corp. May 25th 1865.Discharged by Gen Order. June 9th 1865.Died 10.5.1897.Buried Togus National Cemetery Kennebec Co. Maine Plot J 1340

**Sharp William** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs. Died at Washington D.C. Dec.15th 1862.Buried in Military Asylum Cemetery. Wash D.C.

**Shehan Edward** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs. Discharged on Surgeons Cert.April 10th 1863.

**Smith Henry** Private April 12th 1864 3 Yrs. Discharged by Gen. Order July 1st 1865.

**Smith James** Private April 12th 1864 3 Yrs. Discharged by Gen. Order July 1st 1865.



**Smith John** Private April 6th 1864 3 Yrs. Not on muster out roll.

**Solomon Aarons** Musician Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs. Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865.

**Speer Edwin** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs. Deserted March 8th 1863.

**Speer Leonard** Private Sept.26th 1863 3 Yrs. Drafted. Transferred to Co. A. Date unknown.

**Strouse D** Private No Info 3 Yrs Little Information. Was captured and held Andersonville. Transferred Camp Lawton Millen Ga. and died there. Not buried at Andersonville.

**Sullivan Dennis** Private April 4th 1864 3 Yrs. Discharged by Gen. Order July 1st 1865.

**### Sullivan William** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Died near Petersburg Aug.29th 1864. Brigade commissary. Buried at City Point. Va. Grave E 506. @ M.

**Tassey William** Private July 30th 1863 3 Yrs. Drafted. Captured at Petersburg Va. June 22nd 1864. Absent at muster out.

**Thackeray Samuel (Thacaray)** Private Feb.25th 1864 for 3 Yrs. Born 1842. Wounded and captured in action Boynton Plank Road Va. Oct. 27th 1864. Died at Richmond. Va. Feb 13th 1865. Buried in National Cemetery Henrico Co. Va. Had enlisted aged 22. Was a butcher by trade. Drafted initially into the 71<sup>st</sup> Pa. and transferred into the 69<sup>th</sup> Pa. in 1864.

**Thomas John** Private April 13th 1864 3 Yrs. Not on muster out roll.

**Thompson William** Private April 4th 1864 3 Yrs Discharged by Gen. Order July 1st 1865.

**Tobin Dennis** Private April 16th 1864 3 Yrs. Discharged by Gen. Order July 1st 1865.

**\* \* Todd Patrick (Co. TYRONE)** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs. Born Co. Tyrone Ireland. As an older soldier he volunteered for nursing work during the war. Dishonourably discharged Jan.2nd 1864.

**Tooley William** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs. Discharged on Surgeons cert. Aug 21st 1862

**Ulshafer Jacob** Drafted soldier. Private Sept 14th 1863 3 Yrs. Drafted into Co. F of 71<sup>st</sup> Pa aged 36 then on 12 June 1864 into Co. B of the 69<sup>th</sup> Pa. Absent sick at muster out.

**Walls John** Private 5<sup>th</sup> Sept 1861 at Philadelphia. Re-enlisted Stevensburg Va. 25<sup>th</sup> Feb 1864 .Was promoted Corp 30<sup>th</sup> June 1864.

**\* \* Walls John J (Co. KILKENNY).** Corp. June 30th 1864 3 Yrs Born Kilkenny Ireland 1833. Deserted March 8th 1862 but returned July 20th 1862. Fought at Gettysburg . Prom. Corp. June 30th 1864. Mustered out with Co July 1st 1865. He was married to Elizabeth Donnelly from Carlingford Co Louth. Was a grocer, carpenter and wheelwright. Was member of Post 10 GAR. Both he and wife buried in Cathedral cemetery Philadelphia. Section chapele border Lot 20. Grave 2 S. Wife Catherine Donnelly from Carlingford Co. Louth.

**Waters Henry** Private Jan 19th 1864 3 Yrs. Discharged by Gen. Order July 1st 1865.

**Wells John W.** Private Sept.24th 1863 3 Yrs. Killed at Cold Harbour. June 8th

1864. Buried in National Cemetery Gettysburg. Section D .

**Williams John** Private April 5th 1864 3 Yrs. Discharged by Gen. Order July 1st 1865.

**Yeingst (Yingst) William** Private Sept. 26th 1863 3 Yrs. Drafted. Mustered into the 71st Pa. thence into the 69th. Joined at Pottsville Pa same day as Leonard Syler Co. A. Survived the war and is buried with wife Mary in the Annville United Zion Cemetery Lebanon Co. Pa. Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865. May well have been brother in law of Syler. Syler's wife Catherine's name was Yingst. and was also from Annville. See write up. William married Mary Anna Boddigo and they had two children Harry and Martin. William was detailed to the QM dept. in July 1864. William lived 3.1.1833 until 28.11.1917. Mary lived 13.9.1836 died 12.5.1927.
