Baker George W Private July 1st 1861 3 Yrs. Wounded May 9th 1864. Mustered out July 13th 1864. Expiration of term.

Batdorf John P. Drafted soldier Private. Drafted and mustered in Sept 20th 1863 3 Yrs at Pottsville Pa. to 71st Pa. Transferred to Co. C of the 69th Pa 12th June 1864. Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865. Married to Eliz Glick Batdorf (1831-1906) and had four children. John was born May 8th 1831 and died Oct 26th 1905 aged 74. Buried in the Zoar Lutheran Cemetery Lebanon Lebanon Co. Pa.

Benner John Private 3 Yrs Absent at muster out.

Blakely James 1st Sergt. Aug. 21st 1861 3 Yrs Wounded Aug 25th 1864. Prom. Corporal March 7th 1863. Prom. to Sergt. Nov. 11th 1864. Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865.

Boyer Noah Private July 1st 1861 3 Yrs. Born 1844 Pa. Died 18th Sept 1909. Had been in Co's A and L of the 71st. Pa. Mustered out July 1st 1864. expiration of term. Wife name Rachel M. Buried East Cedar Hill Cemetery Philadelphia. Marker photo.

Boylen Michael Corp Aug. 21st 1861 3 Yrs Born in Ireland 1820. His wife Ellen also born Ireland. He also served in the 24th Pa , 60th Pa. and also the 3rd Pa Heavy Art. Discharged Feb. 28th 1863. Was labourer by trade. Born 1820 Ireland Died April 3rd 1885. Buried Old Cathedral Cemetery Philadelphia

* * **Brady Michael (Co. CAVAN)** 1st Sergt. Aug. 21st 1861 3 Yrs Born Co. Cavan. A labourer by trade. Prom. from Corporal to Colour Sergt. March 18th. 1863. Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865. Took part in a trooping the colour parade in Harrisburg Va. along with Colour Sergt. David Kinery in 1914 of Civil war vets. They representing the 69th. Pa. He had re-enlisted 31st. Jan 1864. He lived in the 5th ward of Philadelphia. Married Margaret McAnally 3rd. April 1864 at St Johns church in Philadelphia. Married by Fr. O'Reilly. They had three children Annie Brady born 8th. Nov. 1867, John Brady born 13th. Oct. 1870 and Mary Brady born 6th. Oct. 1876. Brady died 12th Jan 1919 and is buried in the Holy Cross cemetery Philadelphia. Both his parents also born in Ireland. + \$

Branagan John Private Sept. 12th 1861 3 Yrs Deserted Feb. 27th 1862

Brandon Simon W. Private July 1st 1861 3 Yrs Served 71st Pa. Mustered out July 1st 1864 expiration of term. Died 2nd Jan 1886. Buried Kensington Burial Ground

also known as Palmer St Vault/Palmer St Cemetery. A married wife name Mary. Died Jan 2nd 1886 Wife filed for pension April 8th. 1886. Govt headstone had been ordered on July 1st 1887.

Breininger Jacob Drafted soldier private Sept.24th 1863 3 Yrs. Probably German stock. Deserted but recaptured and sent to Co. D of the 71st transferred to the 69th Co C. June 1864. Wounded in the knee at The Wilderness and in the hand at Hatchers Run 26th March 1865. Was married to wife Sarah in 1855 and had five kids. Lived in Schuylkill Co. Died 6th Sept 1879. Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865. Buried Schuylkill Cemetery Pa. (Headstone image)

* * **Burns Thomas J.** (Co. TYRONE) Private Aug.23rd 1861 3 Yrs Born Co. Tyrone Ireland: Wounded on June 30th 1862 at Glendale and Dec.13th 1862. Deserted on Aug. 8th 1862.

Cahill John 1st Sergt Aug.21st 1861 3 Yrs. Died Dec 29th 1862 from wounds received at Fredericksburg Dec.13th 1862.

Callan Cornelius Private Aug 21st 1861 3 Yrs. Transferred to Vet Reserve Corps Jan 15th 1864.

* * **Campbell James (Co. TYRONE)** Private Aug.21st 1861 3 Yrs. Born Co. Tyrone Ireland: Had history of sickness in service. Eventually dismissed March 1863.

* * **Campbell John** (Co. TYRONE) Private Aug.21st 1861 3 Yrs Born Co. Tyrone Ireland: Wounded at Marye's Heights Dec. 13th 1862. Again wounded at Gettysburg. Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865.

* * **Campbell John (Co. DOWN)** Private Mar. 24th 1864 3 Yrs Born Belfast Co. Down side of city Ireland: Killed at Petersburg June 22nd 1864. Jerusalem Plank Road. Hit on head by shrapnel during a charge against enemy. Had been a weaver in Belfast. Enlisted aged 41. He was 5ft 6ins tall blue eyes and brown hair. Married wife Catherine Taylor in Rosemary St. Presbyterian church Belfast Aug 18th 1840. Daughter Jane born Sept 16th 1857. Lived 1629 South 2nd St .Philadelphia. Weaver by trade. Enlisted age 41.Blue eyes, brown hair. 5ft 6ins tall . Married by the infamous cleric Rev Dean Hanna. Has no known grave as dead in that battle simply buried in pits in many cases and follow up after the war was very limited. May well have enlisted for generous join up bonus towards end of the war. John was the son of a John Campbell who lived in he then famous and still famous Sandy Row near Belfast city a notorious area of Orange /Protestant support then and still is. One wonders how he fitted into a very Irish and Catholic regiment the 69th Pa.

Campbell Joseph Private Feb.3rd 1865 3 Yrs Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865.

* * **Campbell Samuel** (Co.TYRONE) Private Aug.23rd 1861 3 Yrs. Born Co. Tyrone Ireland. Brother to James above. Deserted Oct.23rd 1862

* * **Campbell William** (Co. TYRONE) Private Aug.21st 1861 3 Yrs. Born Co. Tyrone Ireland: Badly wounded at Antietam (Wes Woods) on 17.9.1862.Lost leg. Discharged medically unfit 29.7. 1863. Died aged 59.Noted in 1860 census for Union Vets and Widows as living in Gloucester City Camden N.J. Buried Old St. Marys Cemetery Camden N.J. with wife Mary. Died 29.11.1892.+.

Carmany Jeremiah Private Sept.6th 1863. 3 Yrs. Drafted. Mustered out with Co.

July 1st 1865.

Carroll William Private Aug.21st 1861 3 Yrs. Discharged on Surgeons Cert. Feb.22nd 1863.

* * **Cassery James (Co. CAVAN)** Private Aug.21st 1861 3 Yrs Born Co Cavan Ireland: Deserted Mar.1st 1863 with Privates Martin McDevitt from Co .Clare and John McKinney from Co. Tyrone.

Clinton Henry C. Private July 1st 1861 3 Yrs Joined the 71st Inf at Philadelphia 1.7.1861 and mustered in same day. He was aged 24. On the 12.6.1864 he was transferred to Co. B of the 69th and mustered out 11.7.1864 expiration of term. Died 11.7.1901. Buried Philadelphia National Cem plot MECH/293. He had mustered out July 1 1th 1864 expiration of term. He was on the paperwork of the 69th for a month and unlikely to have fought with them during this short period. +. \$.

* * **Collins John (Co. WATERFORD)** Private Aug 21st 1861 3 Yrs. Discharged on Surgeons cert. Oct.18th 1862. From Co. Waterford.

* * **Connelly Harry** (Co. GALWAY) 1st Sergt. Aug.21st 1861 3 Yrs. Born Co. Galway Ireland: Badly wounded Glendale. Name spelling varies between Conoly, Connolly etc etc. Buried Dayton National Cemetery Dayton Mont Co. Ohio. Plot E.14.33. Died Feb 4th 1886.

Connor Bernard Private Sept 15th 1862 3 Yrs Killed at Fredericksburg Dec.12 1862.doing picket duty.

* * **Coogan William** (Co. LAOIS) 1st Sergt. Aug21st 1861 3 Yrs. Born Co Laois Died 6.7.1863 of wounds received at Gettysburg July 3rd 1863.

Coogan William Private Aug.21st 1861 3 Yrs. Wounded March 1862. Discharged on Surgeons Cert Mar.1862. From Philadelphia.

Cooper John C. Private Mar.21st 1864 3 Yrs Drafted. Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865.

Philadelphia . Buried in Plot E-7-32 2nd from Eas

* * **Costello James 2nd (Co. CARLOW)** Private Aug. 23rd 1861 3 Yrs. Died at Bolivar Heights Va. Oct 17th 1862 from dysentery. Had married Eliza Keating in 1849. Born in Borris Co. Carlow Ireland. After he died wife returned to Ireland and pension paid there. No information where buried.

Costello James A. Enrolled 21.6.1861 at Philadelphia and mustered in 31st Oct 1861 as Pvte. then promoted Corp Aug.23rd 1861at Camp Observation Ms. Wounded Glendale 30th June 1862. Wounded at Gettysburg July 3rd 1863. Shell wound to right hand. Transferred to Vet. Reserve Corps Jan 14th 1864. James did not marry and died in Philadelphia from dropsy Jan 29th 1893. He worked all his life as a labourer. He was buried at the Old Cathedral cemetery Philadelphia from he home of his mother at 14 Leeds Ave Broad and Vine St. 3rd Aug. 1893. He was aged 52.Father James and mother Annie born Ireland as were siblings John, Lawrence (a blacksmith by trade), Mary and Andrew (night watchman) as per 1880 census. Father and other male siblings labourers. James had served in the Army Aug 10th 1861 until Feb. 28th 1864 a period of 2 years, 5 months and 16 days. Buried Old Cathedral Cemetery @ M.

* * **Cronin John (Co. KERRY)** Private Feb.17th 1862 3 Yrs Born Co. Kerry

Ireland: Fought Gettysburg. Deserted July 7th 1863..Buried in Plot E-7-32 2nd from East

Cronshaw James Private Feb.2nd 1864 3 Yrs.Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865

* * **Cullen Andrew** (Co. DONEGAL) Private Aug.21st 1861 3 Yrs. Born Co. Donegal Ireland: Fought at Gettysburg. Wounded at Antietam Sept. 17th 1862.Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865.

Cunningham Peter Private June 28th 1861 3 Yrs Wounded May 14th 1864.Mustered out July 13th 1864 at expiration of term.

Cunningham Robert J. Private Born Philadelphia 1843. Enlisted Philadelphia 71st Pa.1.7.1861 Re-enlisted Stevensburg Va 25.2.1864 for 3 years . Transferred to 69th Pa. 12.6.1864. Buried Old Cathedral Cemetery Philadelphia. Was a butcher by trade. 5ft 5ins.Grey eyes Died Philadelphia Oct 26th 1898.

Curley James Private April 13th 1864 3 Yrs Born Ireland: Captured Petersburg Va June 22nd 1864 and held at Andersonville Survived incarceration there. Absent at Camp Parole Md at muster out. Had the trade of a boat builder.

* * **Daley Thomas** (Co. OFFALY) Private Aug 23rd 1861 3 Yrs. Born Co. Offaly Deserted Oct. 19th 1862.

Davis Jesse Private Sept 26th 1863 3 Yrs Drafted. Absent sick at muster out. NOTE: See bio on this man on separate section of website. He was in fact an ex Confederate soldier called Robert R Howington from Powder Springs Ga who had fought in the 44th Ga. Infantry and after Gettysburg was captured and changed sides.

Devine James Private Aug.21st 1861 3 Yrs Discharged on Surgeons Cert.Dec.30th 1862.

Dolan Timothy Private July 20th 1863 3 Yrs Drafted. Transferred to Vet. Res. Corps Feb 15th 1865.Discharged by Gen Order July 20th 1862.

Donnelly John Private Aug. 23rd 1861 3 Yrs. Deserted Feb. 28th 1862

* * **Donohue Owen** (Co. Fermanagh) Private Aug. 21st 1861 3 Yrs Badly wounded at Antietam Sept 17th 1862.Mustered out Aug.28th 1864 expiration of term. Died in Philadelphia Sept 13 1865 buried in the Old Cathedral cemetery Philadelphia under the large Atkinson family headstone with various other family members of his extended family. (Headstone photo). Plot P-10-50.

* * **Dougherty Charles** (Co. CAVAN) 1st Sergt. Aug.21st 1861 3 Yrs aged 34. Born Co Cavan Ireland 1826. Died Philadelphia April 20th 1864 aged 38. Cause of death delirium tremens having fallen off a rail car 16th April 1864 in an intoxicated state and fractured his skull . Taken to the Cuyler hospital Germanstown initially Was a married man wife Elizabeth Buried Old Cathedral Cemetery Philadelphia April 24th. 1864. Brother to Michael below. He had re-enlisted at Stevensburg 1.2.1864. Had mustered in as Sergt. 31.10.1861 at Camp Obs, Md.

Dougherty (Doherty) John Private Feb 3rd 1865 3 yrs. Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865.Born Ireland 1833. Died June 13th 1883. Buried New Cathedral Cemetery Philadelphia Section 5 R4-No 31 East. Had enrolled Norristown Pa. Aged 41 on enlisting. Dark complexion height 6ft. blue eyes, dark hair a dray driver by profession, From Union Co.

* * **Dougherty Michael** (Co. CAVAN) Enr. 21.8.1861 3 yrs. at Philadelphia. **M.I.**

31.10.1861 Camp Obs as Corp. aged 23 to 2nd. Lieut 27.4.1863. Wounded June 30th 1862 at Glendale. Discharged Jan 5th 1864 by G.C.M. for disobeying orders while on recruitment duties Philadelphia. Brother to Charles above.

Douglass John M Private July 1st 1861 3 Yrs Mustered out July 1st 1864 expiration of term.

Drain James Private Aug.23rd 1861 3 Yrs. Killed at Antietam Sept.17th 1862.

Driebelbies Daniel (John Ritz) Private Aug.1st 1864 3 Yrs. Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1864. See entry for John Ritz.

*** * Duff James** (Co. WICKLOW) Private Aug.23rd 1861 3 Yrs Born Co. Wicklow Ireland: Fought at Gettysburg. Transferred to Vet Res. Corps Dec.15th 1863.

Eckert John (Accord). Private July 1st 1861 3 Yrs aged 38. Born c1823. He had initially joined the 71st Pa Inf. Co. A but was later transferred to the 69th Pa. on 12th June 1864 Co. A. Captured Reams Station Aug. 25th 1864, imprisoned he died of disease and malnutrition at Salisbury prison camp in N. Carolina on Oct 28th. 1864. He was a metal worker by trade, 5ft 10 ins tall, dark eyes, dark hair, born Philadelphia. The spelling of his name varies quite a lot on different files. Buried in a mass trench grave at Salisbury prison along with two of his 69th comrades Timothy Lynch Co. C and Moore Co. D.

Elliott William Fell Private Aug.23rd 1861 3 Yrs English born soldier who married in Oxford England Mary Druwitt 5th. Aug 1849. His father was a cabinet maker. Emigrated to America and joined the 69th Pa at Philadelphia Aug.1861. Plagued by bad health he was discharged on Surgeons Cert. Sept 24th 1862. He died in Philadelphia 31st Oct 1862 and was buried in the Philadelphia Memorial Park (Fraser) 2nd. Nov 1. 1862.His widow later married a Mr Phelan. Buried Plot C-14-21.@

*** * Fagan Thomas** (Co. DONEGAL) 1st Sergt. Feb 17th 1862 3 Yrs. From Co. Donegal Ireland: Fought Gettysburg. Prom. to 2nd Lieut. Co. H. Nov. 11th 1864

*** * Fahey Michael** (Co. MAYO) Private Aug.23rd 1861 3 Yrs. Born Co. Mayo. Had fought Gettysburg 1863 Captured Spotsylvania May 12th 1864. Held at Andersonville Ga. Died there of scorbutus 21st. Oct. 1864. Grave 11261

*** * Farrell William (Alias William Giblin)** (Co. GALWAY) Enlisted as private Aug.24rd 1861 3 Yrs Born Co. Galway Ireland: Wounded July 3rd 1863 at Gettysburg. Deserted July 13th 1863. Changed his name to William Giblin and joined the Navy Marine Corps as a private. Note on his papers referring to Navy document I.E. 11086. Pension April 1st 1912.A married man wife Bridget Farrelly. Died Philadelphia 13th 1912. Buried Holy Cross Cemetery Yeadon Pa. Section T Range 9 Lot 34 Grave 2. Requiem Mass was at the Church of St Thomas Aquinas .He was a member of A.O.H. Div 10 and had worked as a groomsman.

Farrelley Hugh Private Aug 23rd 1861 3 Yrs. Died at Savage Station Va June 29th 1862.

Fie George Pvt 1861 3 Yrs. Started off in the 71st Regt. Transferred to 69th after Gettysburg. Wounded several times once at the Wilderness. With last wounding before the end of the war he ended up his service at the Armoury Hospital Wash D.C. Survived and died Nov 14th 1896. A cabinet maker by trade. He left widow and five children. Buried in the Leverington Cem, Roxborough Pa. Plot Lot 6

Finen Hugh Private Aug 23rd 1861 3 Yrs Deserted date unknown.

Fish Nelson Private July 1st 1861 3 Yrs. Mustered out July 1st 1864 expiration of term. Born 1842 died 1934 aged 92 Wife name Pauline. Buried with wife Monument Cemetery Beverley Burlington Co. N.J. Originally in Co I 71st Pa and then 69th Pa end of service.

Fitzpatrick Charles 2nd Lieut. Aug.21st 1861 3 Yrs. Wounded June 30th 1862. Prom. to 2nd Lieut. May 1st 186?. Then to 1st Lieut but not mustered. Resigned Aug 11th 1863. Born Ireland 1836 Died Philadelphia Nov 11th. 1893. Buried in the New Cathedral Cemetery.

Fletcher. George W. Corp Aug.21st 1861 3 Yrs Absent at muster out.

Flood Benjamin Private July 3rd 1861 3 Yrs Mustered out July 1st 1864 expiration of term. He had initially served in the 71st. Pa. but transferred to the 69th Pa. on 12,6,1864. Had enlisted aged 20.

Flood Hugh (CO.DONEGAL) 1st. Lieut. Enlisted 11th. Sept. 1861. He was wounded at the battle of Fredericksburg Va. Dec 15th 1862. He had married a Rose McFadden also born in Ireland 4th. Sept 1861 in the cathedral of St. Peter and Paul in Philadelphia. She was born 1844 in Ireland and died 5th July 1908 in Philadelphia. He received a disability pension which was allocated to his widow after his death. Hugh emigrated from Ireland arriving in New York April 28th 1851 on the ship Tam O'Shanter. He was about 20-24 years of age. Gave his occupation as farm servant. Along with Hugh was a girl called Ellen Flood possibly his sister or a niece. Both may have remained in Liverpool for a short period as they listed in the 1850 census living at the same address. By the end April 1851 Hugh was in New York. By 1861 at the latest he was in Philadelphia and married by the end of Sept. of 1861. He married a girl called Rose McFadden probably from the Buncrana area of Co. Donegal. She had emigrated aged 6 along with her father Neal, mother Margaret and sister Elizabeth to Philadelphia from Derry on the ship Mary Ann 1852 from Londonderry Hugh and Rose had a family of seven children. Hugh died aged 57 Oct 11th 1899. He and wife buried Holy Cross Cemetery Philadelphia Plot Section 3 Range 9. Lot 48 grave 28. @ M.

Foyle James E. Private 31st July 1861 3 years aged 22. Born Philadelphia Feb 7th 1839. Fought in Co's A and L of the 71st Pa and transferred to Co. C 69th Pa probably 12th June 1864 Born in Philadelphia to Edward Foyle and wife Margaret both born in Ireland. Edward and his wife Margaret had eight children one of which was James E. Foyle the soldier we considering. Edward the father had himself enlisted aged 53 in the 71st. Pa Infantry 9th Aug 1861 in Wash D.C. about a week after his son. Edward the father died Philadelphia 25th April 1866 and is buried in the Old Cathedral Cemetery. Edward's wife Mary died 1st Oct. 1873 and is buried alongside her husband. Edward only served for a short time and was discharged in 1862 by Surg. Cert of Disc. James E Foyle his son survived the war and ended up his days in the N.W. branch of the National Old Soldiers Home in Milwaukee Wisc and is buried in Wood National Cemetery Milwaukee Milwaukee Co. Wisc. Plot 18 grave 75. He died there March 20th 1911. His wife Mary "Maggie" is buried in the extensive family plot Old Cathedral Cemetery Philadelphia Section B. Range 6. Lot

27. James E's parents buried in same plot area. He had been wounded in the right leg by gunshot . Place or date of battle unknown as now. Noted as being absent at muster out presumably in hospital. NOTE. This man has been off "the radar" for a long time as his name was recorded in such listings as Bates as being called Fogle not Foyle. As to which part of Ireland the Foyles were from it is very likely from the Co Laois/Dublin area.

Funk Frederick Private Aug.21st 1861 3 Yrs. Wounded June 30th 1862 mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865.

Gallagher John Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Wounded in action Nov 27th 1863. Discharged Jan 7th 1865. Re-enlisted as Private Jan. 31st 1864 for 3 Yrs. Wounded July 6th 1864.

Gallagher William (CO. TYRONE) Enlisted 21st Aug 1861 at Philadelphia aged 31. He took ill during the Antietam campaign and hospitalised at Harpers Ferry where he got involved in doing hospital work. He ended up serving as a soldier proper when he returned to full operational duties by late Sept 1863. He missed Gettysburg. He re-enlisted Feb 1st. 1864. However he was wounded at Cold Harbour June 6th 1864. He was wounded on back of his head and was in Filbert St. Hospital by June 13th. Then transferred to the VRC June 25th 1865 and was discharged by July 1st 1865. He was about 5ft 6ins tall, dark hair, light complexion, blue eyes. A married man wife Rose or Rosa. Died in Philadelphia March 13th 1871. His death notice in the Phila Inq. Mach 15th 1871. Buried in the Old Cathedral Cemetery Philadelphia in plot Range C-6- 22. @ .

Gallen Patrick Private Aug.23rd 1861 3 Yrs. Died from typhoid at Falmouth Va. Mar 19th 1863.

Good John Private Aug 23rd 1861 3 Yrs. Deserted Feb.27th 1862.

Gossman Henry Private July 1st 1861 3 Yrs Henry lived 1843 -1923. Mustered out July 1st 1864 expiration of term. Was in the 71st PA and then joined the 69th Penn. (Probably in unit a very short time). Buried in the Fernwood Cemetery. Royersford. Mont Co. Pa.

Harper George W. Private Aug.7th 1861 3 Yrs. Joined 71st Pa. Inf 23. 7.1861 at Wash D.C. Mustered in Wash D.C. 7.8.1861. Mustered out Sept. 9th 1864 expiration of term. He had been transferred to the 69th Co. B 12.6.1864. Was from Bucks Co. Pa. Born Bucks Co. 25th Sept 1842 died 26th Aug 1897. Buried St Andrews Church Cem. Yardley Bucks Co. Pa along with his wife.

Harris Edward Private April 1st 1864 3 Yrs. Not on muster out roll.

Haw William Private Aug.23rd 1861 3 Yrs Wounded at Fair Oaks by sabre cut and again at Antietam Md. Sept 17th 1862 gun shot wounds on forearm and shoulder. Discharged on Surgeons Cert. April 16th 1863. Wife Margaret got pension. .Was held in high esteem by his Captain James O'Reilley. "No better soldier than he was. He was always ready to do his duty and wanted to be where the hard fighting was". Born Ireland 1814 and died in Philadelphia April 4th 1868. Was buried in the now defunct St. Marys Cemetery Philadelphia. +.

Haigh Thomas Private July 1st 1861 3 Yrs Raised in the Frankford Pa area, Enrolled and mustered in 71st Pa Inf. Co. L. Philadelphia 1st July 1861 and mustered in Wash D.C. same day. Aged 26. Transferred to Co. C 69th Pa 12th June

1864. Mustered out July 12th. 1864 expiration of term. Born 1835 died 2nd April 1869 from T.B. aged 34. Buried Cedar Hill Cem. Philadelphia.

Henderson Thomas Private April 15th 1864 3 Yrs Deserted June 4th 1864.

C. of the 69th Pa. on 12th June 1864 but noted as being absent sick at muster out. He was born 18th July 1840 and died 28th Sept 1886. Buried in the Nisky Cemetery Philadelphia.

Johnson Bernard W Private July 1st 1865 3 Yrs Mustered out July 16th 1864 expiration of term.

Johnson Peter Private Mar.24th 1864 3 Yrs Not on muster out roll.

Kane Michael Enlisted as Corp musician aged 16 Aug. 21st 1861 for 3 Yrs.

He was plagued by poor health and noted as being hospital in Oct. 1862. In March 1863 he deserted and was AWOL until Jan 12th 1864 when he was arrested. He was fined \$30 dollars for this. However under orders from Gen Webb he was reinstated in Feb. 3rd. 1864. He was given hospital duties in June 1864. This he did until he was discharged Aug.28th 1864 when he mustered out. One source states that he was a tailor by trade. He would appear to have remained in the army system as he probably lived in an Old Soldiers Home in the Mountain Home National Cemetery Johnson City TN. Grave plot B-9-2. (Photo marker).

King David 1st Sergt. Aug 21st 1861 3 Yrs. Prom. from Private to Sergt. Dec 26th 1863. Wounded June 30th 1862. Captured May 6th 1864. Absent at muster out.

King Patrick Private July 1st 1861 3 Yrs Discharged Jan 24th 1863 for wounds received at Antietam Sept. 17th 1862.

*** * Kiniry David (Co. CORK)** Colour Sergt Aug 21st 1861 3 Yrs Born Co. Cork Ireland. 22nd. April 1837. Came into the 69th via the 24th. Pa Regt . Was promoted to Colour Sergt and carried the regimental green flag on July 2nd and 3rd at Gettysburg. Was wounded in the hip at Reams Station. Survived the war and lived until aged 87. He died 7.11.1922 living at 5547 Pearl St Philadelphia. Buried 10.11.1922 to the Old Cathedral cemetery . Section U Range 1 Plot 56. 2 North. Wife was called Mary Downey who died 30.3.1883. File No. 100375.22 Registered 222. Fathers name William and mothers name Mary. Said to have married a 2nd. time to a Johanna Henry. Took part in a veterans parade in Harrisburg Va in 1914 along with 1st Sergt. Michael Brady. Both men were close friends and Kiniry signed a pension affidavit for Brady April 19th. 1919. Buried from Our Lady of Victory church in Philadelphia

Korndoffer Philip Private July 1st 1861 3 Yrs Mustered out July 1st 1864 expiration of term. Born Nov 22nd 1835 Philadelphia died Nov 27th 1924. Philadelphia. Served in Co. A of the 71st Pa and ended up his military service in Co. C of the 69th. Buried in Northwood Cemetery Philadelphia.. Son of Samuel and Eliza Korndaffer nee Baum. Broher to Anna 1869-1860.

Lamb Matthew Private Aug.23rd 1861 3 Yrs. Deserted Dec.30th 1861

Langen David Private Aug.23rd 1861 3 Yrs. Discharged date unknown.

Lewis Harman T Corp April 15th 1864 3 Yrs. Absent on detached duty at muster out.

Lightsinger (Leuzinger) David Private April 5th 1864 3 Yrs Transferred to Co. H Vet Res, Corps date unknown. Born 1843 Switzerland Died at Camp Curtin Pa. Mar 14th 1865 from typhoid pneumonia. Buried Harrisburg Cemetery Harrisburg Dauphine Co. Pa. Grave or Lot No 98.

Little James Private July 2nd 1861 3 Yrs. Mustered out July 1st 1864 expiration of term.

Logue Hugh Enlisted 19.2.1864 at Stevensburg Va. And mustered in same day. Aged 40, ruddy complexion 5ft 7 1/2 ins tall, grey eyes brown hair. A tavern keeper by trade. Born Ireland .His initial enlistment papers lost. .

Long Joseph Private July 1st 1861 3 Yrs Mustered out July 1st 1864 expiration of term. Was in fact in the 71st Pa for his war service. Left after battle of Cold Harbour. Joseph was a "paper" transfer from the 71st Pa to finish his term. He died 21st Sept 1901 aged 65. Buried Mount Moriah cemetery Sept 24th.1901. Worked for the Allison Manufacturing Co. His obituary in the P.I. Sept 24th 1901 which invited surviving members of the 69th to attend.

*** * Lundy Thomas (Co. DOWN)** Private 22nd 12.1862. Wounded Gettysburg July 1863. To VRC 15th March 1864 and given Surgeons cert of discharge 26th Sept 1864. Lived at both Dayton Oh. Old soldiers home and also Togus Home Me. Died July 19th 1872 in poverty on the street 34th and Derby Road Philadelphia on way to alms house. His death recorded in a small insert in the Philadelphia Inquirer Sat. July 20th. 1872. It notes that he was on his way to an alms house when overcome by heat. Close by him lay a valise containing all his effects including a pension paper made out in the name of Thomas Lundy of Co C Sixty Nineth Regiment and discharge from a soldiers home in Washington City. Died of starvation in captivity in Salisbury Prison. Buried P.O.W trench grave in Salisbury National Cemetery Salisbury Rowan Co. N.C. Had engaged aged 33 at Philadelphia. 21.8.1861

Philadelphia. He had fair hair, 5ft 6ins tall, blue eyes, a puddler by trade. Re-enlisted Stevensburg Va. Died 28.11.1864.

Maher John Private Aug 27th 1861 3 Yrs Discharged on Surgeons Cert. Jan 8th 1863.

McCuen (McEwan) John Private. 1st July 1861. 3yrs. Was in Co's A and L of the 71st Pa Then transferred to Co. C 69th Pa June 12th 1864. He is noted as having deserted from Camp Convalescence 11th Nov 1864. Died 22nd May 1916 Philadelphia aged 79. A small man 5ft 4ins brown hair blue eyes. Was a cook by trade. Buried in the Oakland Cem. Philadelphia. Section C Lot 291 Grave 1 Internment No. 4537. Some of his records show his name a McEwan or McEwen. He was buried from his son in laws Wm. Reed's house at 3150 Potter St to St Johns Episcopal church and thence a private ceremony in Oakland Cemetery Philadelphia.

Buried Greenwood Cemetery Philadelphia. Was a married man. Some documents have him as McGew.

Wounded battle of Fair Oaks, a flesh wound. Also wounded at battle of Jerusalem Plank Road. Wounded June 22nd 1864 and on March 25th 1865 a knee wound at Hatchers Run. Prom. to Sergt. April 25th 1864 to 1st Sergt. Nov.11th 1864.

Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865.Fought at the Wall at Gettysburg. Died Philadelphia 29th. Sept.1884. Buried in the New Cathedral cemetery Philadelphia plot T-8-20.Fair hair, 5ft 10 ins. Grey eyes. Labourer by trade. Mustered out 1.7.1865.

*** * McGlinchy Patrick** (Co. DONEGAL) Private. Enlisted Aug.21st 1861 3 Yrs From Stranorlar Co. Donegal Ireland: Born Stranorlar Co. Donegal 1821. Enlisted aged 40 Wounded in hand at Glendale 30.6.1862. Fought at the Wall at Gettysburg.

After recovery post Gettysburg he was detailed to the Division Ambulance Corps. on Jan 1864 and as a nurse in the Division hospital in July 1864. Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865. Died in Philadelphia aged 90 years Jan 12th 1904 His family emigrated as Famine era emigrants presumably via Derry to Philadelphia .Height 5ft 5ins, dark complexion,, brown eyes, dark hair. Discharged on Surgeons Cert Sept. 5th 1862. Died aged 61 in the National Home DVS near Dayton Ohio 29th. April 1878. Buried in Section A. Row 8 Site 71 Dayton National Cemetery Dayton Ohio.

McKenna Michael Private Aug.23rd 1861 3 Yrs Discharged on Surgeons Cert. Oct. 14th 1862. Born Ireland 1829 Died Philadelphia March 28th 1868 Buried in the Old Cathedral cemetery Philadelphia S. Border Grave 121. He had enlisted Aug 19th 1861 but was discharged on Surgeone Cert of Discharge Oct 14th 1862. Was a married man. Plot A-1-17. @.

**** McKinney John** (Co. TYRONE) Private Aug.23rd 1861 3 Yrs Born Co. Tyrone Ireland: Deserted Mar.1st 1863.Never returned.

**** McNulty James** (Co. TYRONE) Private Jan.3rd 1863 3 Yrs Born Co. Tyrone Ireland: Died July 6th 1863 of wounds received at Gettysburg 3rd July 1863.

**** McQuillan Thomas** (Co. DERRY) Private 21st. Oct. 1860 3 Yrs. Born Co Derry circa 1822. Probably in the Magherafelt area of Co. Derry. Emigrated as a married man with two children. Enlisted 21.10.1862 aged 38 at Philadelphia. Badly wounded in skull at Fredericksburg Dec. 13th 1862. Was in the Harness Lane hospital in Philadelphia in 1863. Transferred to the VRC Dec 1st 1863 and discharged from that organisation 9th March 1866. Badly brain damaged he had a life of ill health and his medical records show his problems worsening in the latter years of the 1870's. Daughter Ellen looked after him for over 10 years along with helpers. Was married to Anna (Long or McPhillips?) also born in Ireland circa 1820. Thomas died 20th Aug 1883 and was buried from 1827 Carpenter St 30th Ward to the Old Cath. Cemetery. Plot Z-13-67 which appears to be the family grave plot. At one stage Capt James Reilly of Co. Born Sept 15th 1824 died Oct 26th 1889 from cancer. Buried from the Erie Old Soldiers Home Erie Pa, to the local Veterans Memorial Cemetery Erie Pa, plot section C Row 4 Grave 8. @ M.

O'Connor John Capt. Aug.21st 1861 3 Yrs. Prom. from 2nd to 1st Lieut Mar.27th 1863. Discharged April 26th 1863 Re-commissioned May 26th 1864. Prom Capt Mar.1st 1865. Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865 carrying some very bad wounds. He was born Aug 24th Philadelphia. He had enlisted in the 24th Pa on Sept 24th 1861 thence into Co C 60th Pa. promoted through the years to 1st Lieut then Captain. Died Oct 24th 1890 and is buried St Patricks Shrine Church Cemetery Carlisle Cumberland Co. Pa. John died aged 50 His wife Roseanna Arney died aged 40 in the 1880's (seems to be 1881 on headstone). Left a son who reared by a member of his mothers family. Some documents have his name as Connor.

He later founded an academy at Chestnut Hill Philadelphia where he lived. The family Presbyterian and belonged to the Democratic party forming up in Philadelphia pre Civil War. Rose to be promoted Brig. Gen. 29th Nov. 1862. A married man he died aged 66 Nov 7th 1887 from general disability. Buried South Laurel Cemetery Nov 10th. 1887. from his residence Chestnut Ave. Chestnut Hill. 22nd ward. (Photo)

Thompson George Private April 21st 1864 3 Yrs. Died Aug.27th of wounds received at The Wilderness May 6th 1864.

Thompson James H. Sergt. March 25th 3 Yrs Captured wounded at The Wilderness Va. 6th May 1864. Sent Millen Ga. Parolled and sent to Savannah Nov 19th 1864. Sent Annapolis Md and admitted Hospital Div No 1 Nov 25th 1864 thence Baltimore Nov 27th 1864 then McClellan General Hospital and recovered and released June 27th 1865. Mustered ot July 10th 1865.

Toner Michael Private Aug.23rd 1861 3 Yrs. Wounded at Gettysburg July 3rd 1863.Discharged Sept. 20th 1864.

Toner William Corp Aug.23rd.1861 3 Yrs. Killed at Charles City Cross Roads June 30th 1862

Toy Bernard Private Aug.23rd 1861 3 Yrs.Killed at Fredericksburg Dec.13th 1862. His father Bernard Toy and mother Margaret married in Co. Tyrone in July 1832 by the Rev Neal? Flaherty. His father would appear from his mothers pension application to have been in the British Army and died in the East Indies in 1841. Unclear if father was perhaps an English soldier garrisoned in Tyrone who married a local girl as some did. As to how Margaret and Bernard made their way to Philadelphia we may never know. One scenario is that Bernard was born in the East Indies and after fathers death they came home to Tyrone thence to America.

Wagner Joseph Private Aug 23rd 1861 3 Yrs. Wounded at Fredericksburg Dec.13.1862. Discharged Dec.17th 1864.

*** * Ward John** (Co. DONEGAL) Private Aug.23rd 1861 3 Yrs. c1825. Fought at the Wall at Gettysburg. Deserted Sept 9th 1863. Served in the medical unit. Wifes name Isabella. John is buried in the Fairmont Cemetery Newark New Jersey. From paperwork on hand his route to America was via the port of Derry. A port where thousands of Donegal and west Co, Derry emigrants sailed to America.. Born circa 1825 died 27th. Nov 1885 aged 59. Had fought in front of the famous clump of trees at the Wall Gettysburg. Died Nov 27th 1885 Newark N.J. Buried in the Fairmont Cemetery Newark Essex Co. N.J. @.

Waters Bernard 1st Sergt. Aug.21st 1861. 3 Yrs. Killed at Charles City Cross Roads. June 30th 1862.

Welsh (Walsh) Michael Private Aug. 26th 1861 3 Yrs. Aged 34.Transferred ambulance Corps. April 1863. Caught yellow fever Gettysburg Hospitalised South St. hospital Philadelphia and died there 1.10.1863 Buried in the Old Cathedral Cemetery Philadelphia. Oct 4th 1863. Grave Section K Range 5 Row 24 2nd from west. Wife named Ellen buried in same plot.@.

Welsh John James Private Aug. 23rd 1861 3 Yrs Captured at Savage Station June 29th 1862.

**** Welsh William** (Co. TYRONE) Enlisted as Private aged 36 Aug. 22nd 1861 3 Yrs Born Co. Tyrone. He had also served in the 214th PVI. Discharged Nov. 19th 1862 for wounds received in action at Glendale Va. 30th June 1862. Gun shot wounds left leg. Wife Margaret also born Ireland died 18th March 1918 aged 76 and is also buried in the same cemetery. William died Feb 2nd 1895 and he is buried in the Old Cathedral Cemetery Philadelphia 6th Feb 1895 plot F.4.11. West Margin. New.@

Wenson Daniel Private July 29th 1864 3 Yrs. Wounded March 25th 1865. Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865.

Whitman John Private Aug. 23rd 1861 3 Yrs Deserted Sept 9th 1863.
