* * **Allen Henry (Co. TYRONE)** Sergt. Oct. 16th 1862 3 yrs Born Co. Tyrone Ireland: Wounded at Gettysburg July 3rd 1863. Prom. from Private Aug. 23rd 1864. Absent sick at muster out.

Alrich Canby B Private Aug. 2nd 1862 3 Yrs Discharged by order of Sec. of War May 10th 1865.

Baker Jackson Private April 12th 1864 3 Yrs Captured at The Wilderness May 6th 1864. Held in Andersonville Ga. Survived the incarceration. Absent at muster out.

Barnes John 2nd Lieut Sept 1st 1861 3 Yrs Resigned Feb 28th 1862. Born Baltimore Md 1832. Died Philadelphia Dec 8th 1908. Also served in Co. D 23rd Pa, the 31st Pa. 191st Pa and Spears Ind Militia. Buried Holy Cross Cem. Yeadon Pa. Was married to Mary Teague or McTeague. Plot 16.2.7.

Barritt James J. Private Oct. 31st 1861 3 Yrs Transferred to Co. A. Dec. 10th 1862.

Barritt John Private Oct. 31st 1861 3 Yrs Deserted June 2nd 1863.

Bassett Robert Private Oct. 31st 1861 3 Yrs Deserted Feb 2nd 1862.

Beckman Thomas Private Aug. 6th 1861 3 Yrs Absent sick at muster out.

Bell John M Private Aug. 19th 1861 3 Yrs Discharged on Surgeons Cert. Date unknown .

* * **Biggins Matthew** (Co. CAVAN) Private Aug. 1st 1861 3 Yrs Born Cavan Ireland Sept 17th 1835. Emigrated to America probably famine times. Most likely to Philadelphia area. Enrolled in the 71st Pa Inf at Philadelphia 1.7.1861. and mustered in at Wash D.C. 8.7.1861 into Co C of the Regt. He was 26 years of age. He was promoted Corp. rank 22.7.1862. He was wounded at Gettysburg 2.7.1863 and appears to have been hospitalised. He was discharged 2.7.1864. a year to the day after Gettysburg. He had married Deborah McGrath a native of Limerick in Camden N.J. April 3rd 1864. in Camden N.J. Matthew rejoined the Union Army and went west with them and served many years in the forts of S. Dakota during the Indian wars. After living in several Union army forts in S. Dakota they eventually settled in Bonesteel area of S. Dakota and raised their family. Many of the children (some 10 off) had been born at the various forts. Matthew and Deborah died in the Wheeler

area Both are buried in St Marys cemetery in Bonesteel. (See bio on him on webpage)

Boyd Amos S. Private July 3rd 1863 3 Yrs Drafted. Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865. Balls Cross Roads Va.

* * **Boyle Cornelius** (Co. FERMANAGH) Private Aug 19th 1861 3 Yrs Discharged on Surgeons Cert July 15th 1864. Born Co Fermanagh.

Brooks I. Henry Private Aug 1st 1861 3 Yrs Captured at Spotsylvania Court House Va. May 12th 1864. Held Andersonville Ga Survived Exchanged Savannah Ga. Nov 14th 1864. Absent at muster out.

Brown Robert Private Jan 4th 1864 3 Yrs Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865.

Buchan ? Private Aug.25th 1861 3 Yrs Wounded in action May 30th 1864. Discharged Dec.5th 1864.

Callahan James Private July 22nd 1861 3 Yrs Wounded at Spotsylvania Court House May 12th 1864. Absent at muster out.

* * **Campbell William** (Co. DERRY) Private March 24th 1864 3 Yrs Died at Fredericksburg May 12th aged 34 of wounds received at Spotsylvania Court House May 11th 1864. He had joined as a volunteer. From Co Derry.

Carney William (Kearney) (Co. Louth).Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Died at Camp Observation Feb.19th 1862.Buried in the Old Cathedral Cemetery Philadelphia. Wrongly linked to burial Pottsville Methodist Cemetery Poolesville Md. Died from consumption near Poolesville. Buried Feb 24th 1862. Plot section N Range 7 Grave 19. West Margin. He was 26.Buried Family plot no individual marker,

Carr John Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs aged 19. Deserted April 8th 1863 at Fredericksburg Md. Possibly the John who is buried in Mt.Vernon Cemetery? (to be confirmed). Occupation artist. Hair black. Height 5ft 8ins. Fair hair, grey eyes.

Carroll John Private April 4th 1864 3 Yrs Absent sick at muster out.

Cavanaugh John Private Mar 12th 1865 3 Yrs Mustered out with Co. July 1865.

Chambley Barthol'w Private Sept 27th 1861 3 Yrs Enrolled Philadelphia into 71st Pa. 14. 7. 1861.Mustered in Chain Bridge Va.19.9.1861 as Corp aged 20. Within the 71st Pa he moved from Co. M. to Co. C 29.7.1862. He transferred to Co. F. of the 69th Pa. 12.5.1864. and discharged 29.9.1864 . Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865 Buried in Philadelphia National Cemetery Plot F 458.

Clark Edward Private Sept 27th 1861 3 Yrs. Killed at Cold Harbour June 5th 1864.Buried in the National Cemetery Cold Harbour Va Sec. A. (Bates indicates Sec. B) Grave A- 167.

Clark Lewis J Private Jan 5th 1864 3 Yrs Mustered out with Co July 1st 1865.

* ***Clark William** (Co. TYRONE) Corp Oct 31st 1861 3 Yrs Born Co. Tyrone Ireland 1837. Wounded at Glendale on he arm. Recovered and returned to unit. Deserted March 1864 and went back to Philadelphia. He then headed to Wilmington Del. And enlisted n 1st Del. Inf. Gave his trade as boatman. Was paid as a substitute private and collected at one stage of \$64.40.War over he returned bak to Philadelphia to wife Elizabeth who he had married in 1860. No family. They lived at

2424 Panama St. Died March 1st 1901. Buried Holy Cross Cemetery Yeadon Del. Co. Pa. Buried Section 13 Range 5 Lot 19. Went by the name William Cahill 1st Del. Regt. Under which his wife was able to claim a pension. No marker (Feb. 2017) but his grave head to head with a small Brennan marker.

**** Cloney John** (Co. CARLOW) Corp April 16th 1864 Born Co. Carlow Ireland 1847: Prom. Corp March 1st 1865. Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865. Died Philadelphia Aug 18th 1887 aged 40. Buried in the Old Cathedral Cemetery Philadelphia. Plot Sec N. Range 8 Lot 55 2nd from west. +.

Condon Patrick Sergt. Oct. 31st 1861 3 Yrs Died at Washington D.C. Sept 8th for wounds received at Reams Station Aug. 25th 1864. Born Ireland 1822. Died Sept 8th 1864 in Lincoln Gen Hospital Wash D.C. Fought at Gettysburg. Wife Ann Condon 1824-1889 is buried Plot F-5-30.. Daughter Ellen C Condon 1824-1889 is also buried Old Cathedral Cemetery Philadelphia. Patrick is buried with daughter Ellen in Plot section L-Range 3 No. 7. @.

Corson Thomas S Private July 1st 1861 3 Yrs Captured at Petersburg and prisoner from June 22nd to Nov 25th 1864. when exchanged at Savannah Ga. Survived Andersonville and mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865.

Crawford John Sydney Private Sept. 4th 1863 3 Yrs Drafted. Born Edinburgh Scotland Nov 19th 1839 Died July 4th 1906 Stonington New London Co. Conn. Buried Trinity Oxford Episcopalian Churchyard Philadelphia Pa. Absent sick at muster out. P.A. Civil war system carries two cards on this man. One has him enlisting into Co B. 71st P.A. 24.9.1863 at Pooleville aged 24 and a note saying he was transferred to Co. F. 69th Pa. 12th June 1864. The other card says he was drafted 4th Sept. 1863 at Poolesville and a note he was sent to the rear by the order of the Sec of War. Buried Trinity Oxford Episcopalian Cemetery Philadelphia.

Crawford Robert Private Oct 31st 1861 3 Yrs Deserted March 25th 1862

Credicks John S Drafted soldier into Co. B 71st Pa 3 years 26th Sept. 1863 then transferred into Co. F 69th Pa 12th June 1864. Absent at muster out. Was sent to rear by order of Sec of War. Was named as John Credick in Pa 71st P.A. cards and as John S. Credicks on 69th P.A. cards.

Cundy Elijah Corp Nov. 20th 1862 3 Yrs Prom Corp. Mar. 1st 1865. Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865. Born England 1845. Died Philadelphia July 15 1904. Also served in the 71st Pa. Buried in Mount Peace Cemetery Philadelphia Section Q Lot 158 Grave No 2. 2nd interment shared with wife Ellen Cundey. 1st Interment buried 16th Aug 1879. No markers on any grave on this lot in cemetery burial records.

**** Devenny Patrick F.** (Co. DERRY) Born Derry city Ireland in the Longtower parish of the city. Private Aug. 19th 1861 3 Yrs Left Derry with his wife Sarah and settled with his children William, Michael, Mary, Margaret, Patrick and Ellen. Family settled in the St Patricks parish by the Schuykill river. Patrick enlisted in Co F. Aug. 19th 1861.. He was aged 50 but gave his age as 46. Fought in the Peninsular campaign, Chantilly, South Mountain and Antietam but died of disease after Antietam and died in hospital at Harpers Ferry on Nov 1st. 1862. Buried in the Old Cathedral Cemetery Philadelphia 15th Nov 1862. His son Michael was in Co. C of

the 116th Pa Inf. His youngest son Patrick enlisted as a substitute in Co. D of the 76th Regt under the name Pat Duffy. Wife Sarah buried with him in same plot. Buried in plot 0-7-14.

**** Devine James (Co. ARMAGH)** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Born Co. Armagh Ireland: Transferred to Vet Corps Aug.17th 1863. One report states he was discharged due to poor health and being too old for combat.

Dickey James Private Aug.19th 1861 3 Yrs Mustered out Aug 27th 1864 expiration of term. Musician. Born 1845 Pa. died March 22nd 1928 Hampton Va. Buried Mount Moriah Cemetery Philadelphia Section 123 Lot 66. Grave 2 Fr. El Res.@.

Diesley William Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Deserted Oct.27th 1862.

**** Doake Robert** (Co. DONEGAL) 1st Sergt. Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Born Co. Donegal Ireland: 1825. Died Philadelphia Feb 27th 1865. Wounded at Antietam Sept. 17th 1862. Captured at Gettysburg July 3rd 1863. Transferred to Vet. Res. Corps Feb 12th 1864. Buried in Odd Fellows Cemetery Philadelphia (Now defunct).

Dobbin Robert Private Aug.19th 1861 3 Yrs Discharged on Surgeons Cert Oct.20th 1862. Born Scotland 1831. Died Jan 3rd 1864 Philadelphia .Buried in the American Mechanics Cemetery Philadelphia (now defunct). He had originally been buried in the Mechanice cemetery Jan 18th 1864 in Div B Sec 10 Lot 8 grave 4. Disinterred 7/20/5 and as remains in case 1 re-interred 7/24/5 in Philadelphia Memorial Cemetery. Probably in mass grave. @

**** Dolan John (Co. SLIGO)** Born Sligo 1811. Enlisted as private Aug 19th 1861 3 Yrs Born Co. Sligo Ireland: 1812 Wounded at Antietam Sept 17th 1862. Fought Gettysburg. Discharged on Surgeons Cert Dec. 21st 1863. Died July 27th 1889 aged 87 in the National Old Soldiers Home in Wauwatosa Milwaukee Co. Wisc. Buried in the Holy Cross Cemetery Yeadon Pa. Buried Section 5 Lot 27 Range 13 Grave 1.

Donnelly John Private April 4th 1864 3 Yrs Born Ireland:. John joined the 69th by request and stayed in the unit throughout the war in Co. F. Mustered out July 1st 1865. From Co. Donegal. Buried Hampton National Cemetery Hampton City Va. Row 9417 Died on Oct 10th 1907.

Dougherty Charles. Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs .Transferred to Vet. Corps April 19th 1865. Born Ireland as was his wife Mary Ann. Also served in the 116th Pa and 24th Pa and also V.R.C. units.

Downey John Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Deserted date unknown.

Downey Michael (Tipperary) Private Aug.19th 1861 3 Yrs aged 42. Discharged on Surgeons Cert. Oct.3rd 1862. Died aged 60 4th Aug. 1863 though his files show various dates. Died from Cholera.4th Aug. 1863. A labourer by trade. A married man wife Bridget who survived him and died aged 73 on Oct 21st 1891. Also born Ireland. Both buried Old Cath. Cemetery Philadelphia plot S-6-24 .@

Doyle John 1st Lieut Sept 15th 1861 3 Yrs Born Ireland: A New Yorker who had been a milliner. Resigned Oct.11th 1862

Dunbar Joseph Private Sept 27th 1861 3 Yrs Wounded at Gettysburg July 3rd 1863. Absent sick at muster out. Joseph was badly wounded in the left forearm at

Gettysburg which ended his army service. His wounds badly affected his nervous system. Initially taken to West Philadelphia Hospital who attended him as well as they could for about 6 months. Because of the damage to his nervous system he was transferred to Turners Lane hospital in a very poor condition his arm wasted as was his body. This hospital had in its employ a Surgeon Silas Weir Mitchell and a Dr Keen who specialised in nervous problem associated with Civil War soldiers. Surgeon Mitchell and Dr Keen kept notes on their cases. They published these notes in a book by J.P. Lippencott in 1872 pages 207-209 in which they refer to Dunbar as being case No 35 and refer to him as J.D. easily identifiable to the regimental roisters. This list all the damage done to his arm in detailed medical terms and what treatment they applied. They note that though greatly improved he still obviously left the hospital with many problems. Sadly about a year later on July 1st 1864 he died from a different cause T.B. Buried in what was then the Odd Fellows Cemetery. Born Ireland probably Co. Derry. Noted as being a carter before the war. When the Odd Fellows Cemetery became defunct his body and all his family members were removed to Lawnview Cemetery Rockledge Mont Co. Pa. Plot Susquehanna Section 39 Grave 18. Remains moved to Lawnview Aug 23rd.1951.

**** Dunn John** (Co. CAVAN) Private April. 1864 3 Yrs Born Co Cavan Ireland: Wounded and captured at Petersburg June 22nd 1864. Died at Andersonville Ga. Aug. 25th 1864 of diarrhoea. Grave 6778.

Eagan - Lacy John 2nd Lieut Sept 11th 1861 3 Yrs Wounded at New Market Cross Va June 30th 1862. Prom. to 2nd Lieut May 1st 1863. Captured at Gettysburg July 3rd 1863. Exchanged Later wounded at Petersburg June 18th 1864. Discharged Dec.10th 1864. Born June 3rd 1833 Died Feb 5 1918. Wife Mary. Buried Old Cathedral Cemetery Philadelphia.

Edwards James Private Aug 19th 1861 3 Yrs Died Sept. 24th Frederick Md. of wounds received at Antietam Sept 17th 1862. Buried Antietam Nat. Cemetery. Grave No 4207.(Photo)

Fitzgerald Edward Private Aug 19th 1861 3 Yrs Discharged on Surgeons Cert. Oct.24th 1862.

**** Fleming John** (Co. DONEGAL) Private Aug.19th 1861 3 Yrs Born Co. Dublin Ireland: Wounded at Gettysburg July 3rd 863. Mustered out Dec. 6th 1864 expiration of term. Died 27th May 1900. Buried Hampton National Cemetery Va. Grave 7944. Section C. (Headstone photo) . Had been admitted to the Pa DVS 16.10.1874 aged 47. Had suffered gun shot wound to hip..

**** Fullerton John** (Co. DERRY) Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Born Annagh Desertmartin Magherafelt Co. Derry 1819. Wounded Antietam. Accidentally killed railroad accident at Washington D.C. Mar. 6th 1864. Was on furlough after reenlisting. Had another brother in Wash D.C who claimed his body and effects. Buried Mount Moriah March 11th 1864 Philadelphia. Was a married man wife Bridger Reilley. Buried from 1335 Kates St Philadelphia. He had enlisted at Philadelphia 19th Aug 1861.He was a labourer by trade. 5ft 9ins tall. He had reenlisted at Stevensburg Va 1st Feb 1864 Buried Mount Moriah Section 200 Lot 51.grave 1.

Gaffney James Private Sept 10th 1861 3 Yrs Deserted July 2nd 1862.

Gallagher Charles Sergt.Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Died date unknown of wounds received at Spotsylvania May 12th 1864.

Galvin Ephraim Private June 7th 1864 3 Yrs Absent sick at muster out.

Gibson William Private Sept 24th 1863 3 Yrs Drafted. Absent sick at muster out.

Gilpin George Private Oct.31st 1861 3yrs Transferred to Vet Reserve Corp April 21st 1864. Born Ireland 1821. Died June 22nd 1894 in Camden Camden Co. N.J. Buried in the Evergreen Cemetery Camden N.J.

Glass John Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs. Deserted May 1864.

Gorman Michael Private Aug.19th 1861 3 Yrs Mustered out on Aug 27th 1864. Expiration of term.

Gormley John Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Deserted Oct.19th 1862.

Gough William Private Aug 19th 1861 3 Yrs Deserted Oct.30th 1861.

Gregg John Sergt. Aug 19th 1861 3 Yrs Born England: Fought Gettysburg. Discharged Mar. 3rd 1864 for wounds received at Mine Run Va Nov 27th 1863. Died March 25th 1870 aged 29 from injuries from a ladder fall on the Grays Ferry Road near the Naval Asylum A married man. Buried Old Cathedral Cem. Philadelphia. A tin smith by trade. Parents Patrick and Bridget Gregg. May have been Irish who lived for a time in England where John born.

Grimes John Private Aug.19th 1861 3 Yrs Discharged on Surgeons Cert Feb 6th 1863. Born Ireland 1823 Died April 10th 1903 in Philadelphia . Also served in the 24th Pa Co E 197th Pa. and 2nd Pa. buried in Holy Cross Cemetery Yeadon Pa. Section 1 Range 8 Lot 14

Hagerty David (Daniel on some paperwork Also Haggerty) Corp Aug.19th 1861 3 Yrs Prom Corp. Oct 12th 1861. Wounded at Gettysburg July 3rd 1863 by cannonball to his face. Sent July 6th to the Cuyler hospital. Recovered and transferred to the Vets Reserve Corps May 12th 1864 but readmitted to hospital May 22nd. Discharged from service Aug. 24th 1864 still suffering from facial wounds. Enlisted aged 38. Lived at the Delaware State Hospital at the end of his life. He is buried there most probably in the Circle of Stones section . Severe mental problems at end of life. Lived at a time in Biddle St above 24th, Philadelphia.

Hamilton James Private Aug.19th 1861 3 Yrs Discharged on Surgeons Cert. April 30th 1863.

Hamilton John Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Born Ireland. 1831 Died on board the hospital ship Euterpe at Fortress Monroe Va. July 19th 1862 from typhoid fever. Was aged 32. Had been a married man wife Nancy. They lived at 815 and 2nd St. Was a clerk by profession. Buried Odd Fellows cemetery Philadelphia Aug.24th 1862. (now defunct).Remains moved to Lawnview cemetery when Odd Fellows closed.

**** Hand James** (Co. MEATH) Private Aug.19th 1861 3 Yrs Born Co. Meath Ireland: Fought in the Mexican war. Captured at Gettysburg July 3rd 1863. Honourably mustered out with Co. Oct. 8th 1864 expiration of term. He hit bad times in his latter years and was buried aged 96 from the Chester Alms House

Marshallton . He had died Jan 21st . 1886. Buried in Potters Field cemetery Marshallton Pa. cemetery probably the United Methodist Church graveyard Marshallton.. Though looked for no marked grave found April 2010. He actually enlisted in the 69th Pa when he was actually 68 saying he was 33. In the 1880 census he is listed living in Cain Township about 8 miles from Marshallton and still working on he railroad. Served 19.8.1861 until 8.10.1864. Born 1790.

Harkins William Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Born Ireland: Deserted March 20th 1863. Never seen again.

Harvey James Private Aug.19th 1861 3 Yrs Enlisted aged 27. Had served in the 24th Pa. Co. A. Badly wounded at Gettysburg. Discharged on Surgeons Cert. Sept.23rd 1863. Buried in the Gattysburg National Cemetery Pa Section D-72.

**** Harvey Patrick (Co. TYRONE)** Private Aug.19th 1861 3 Yrs Mustered out Aug 19th 1864 expiration of term. From Co. Tyrone.

Hastings David C Private Feb 6th 1864 3 Yrs Discharged on Surgeons Cert Oct 8th 1864. Died May 31st 1883. He is buried in Cypress Hills Cemetery Brooklyn Kings Co. N.Y. He was actually discharged for medical reasons 8th. Oct. 1864. Also served in Co A 71st Pa and 130th Pa. Plot section 2 Site 4779.(Marker photo)

**** Heany Robert (Hennerry) (Co.Derry)** Private Aug 18th 1861 3 Yrs Discharged on Surgeons Cert. Aug.11th 1862. Wife Jane A labourer by trade. Died aged 23 from T.B. April 1863 buried Old Cathedral cemetery Philadelphia 27th April 1863. A single man.

Heary Patrick Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Born Ireland: Deserted July 4th 1863.

Henry Thomas Corp Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Died at Annapolis Md. July 11th of wounds received at Gettysburg July 3rd 1863.

**** Hogan Philip (Co. Limerick)** .Private 19.8. 1861 3 Yrs Aged 40. Dark complexion, grey eyes, brown hair. Labourer. Deserted 8.4.1862 Wounded at Antietam Md. Sept 17th 1862. Deserted 8.4.1863 hospital Fredericksburg.

Howard Taylor C 2nd Lieut Oct.9th 1861 3 Yrs Died Nov.7th 1862.

Hughes Andrew Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Wounded at Antietam Sept 17th 1862. Deserted March 21st 1863.

Huplitz Alfred J Private July 1st 1861 3 Yrs Prisoner from June 22nd to Dec.10th 1864. Born 1839 Pa. Died Nov 24th 1915 Philadelphia. Was captured 22nd June 1864 Petersburg and sent to Camp Lawton Millen Ga. Oct 31st 1864 released Dec 10th 1864 mustered out July 1st 1865 at Balls Crossroads Va.. Buried in Mount Peace Cemetery Philadelphia. Also served in Co. A 71st Pa.

Irvin Thomas B Private July 15th 1864 3 Yrs Drafted. Discharged on Surgeons Cert. May 6th 1865.

Johnston William Private Sept 26th 1863 3 Yrs Drafted. Discharged Oct.7th 1865.

Jones George W Private Aug.23rd 1861 3 Yrs Absent sick at muster out.

Keefe David Corp April 25th 1864 3 Yrs Prom. Corp May 1st 1865. Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865. Buried Los Angeles National Cemetery Cal. Plot 61 3/C. Died Nov 8th 1929.

Keith Edward Private June 4th 1864 3 Yrs Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865.

Kelly James Private Born Ireland 1824. Enlisted October 31st 1861 discharged on Cert of Disc Nov 13th 1863. Filed for pension Dec 13th 1864. Was attached to V.R.C. 53 Co. 2nd Batt. Died on Christmas day 1889 in Philadelphia. Buried in the New Cath cemetery Philadelphia aged 65. Born Ireland .A married man. Lived 9. Jenkins Court. Buried 30th Dec 1889. He was involved in the Irish Militia before the war and entered as a 35 yr old Corporal ... demoted in November 1861 to Private ? Got sick in May 1863 (before Gettysburg)..Was captured at Gettysburg 3rd. July 1863 and sent to Camp Lawton Millen Ga. Nov 11th 1864. Was at a time . hospitalized and to V.R.C. Kenyon John Private April 20th 1864 3 Yrs Captured Petersburg Va. June 22nd 1864. Held and survived Andersonville. Absent at muster out.

Kerr (Carr) Thomas Sergt Aug 19th 1861 3 Yrs Joined at the beginning of the war aged 34. Had fought in the Mexican and Indian Seminole (Florida) wars. Was involved in many battles throughout the war. Badly wounded at Mine Run But came back . Later hospitalised at Wash D.C. and Philadelphia after being wounded at the battle of Locust Grove on May 1st 1864 and never really recovered. Died at his home in Philadelphia Jan 6th 1865. He was initially buried in Glenwood Cemetery Philadelphia. However his obituary named him an Charles Karr. When the Glenwood cemetery was closed in 1938 all the remains were removed to Philadelphia Natonal Cemetery Philadelphia Probably his remains in a communal grave. Probably this grave beside or underneath the Mexican Grave Memorial at area MM Site 71. Enrolled Philadelphia 19th Aug 1861 and mustered in 31st Oct 1861 as Sergt. Aged 34. Was a brick maker by trade. Born in Ireland. Light complexion, blue eyes, dark hair. Note: His name was probably Kerr or Carr in Ireland. He signed his name as Kerr. The Scott Legion (and ex Mexican War Vets Association) wrote to the State governor on March 14th 1864 suggesting he be made 2nd Lieut. But this was no granted. On the P.A. Civil War card list he is named as Thomas Carr.

King John 1st. Lieut. Aug.19th 1861 3Yrs Born Ireland 1832. Prom. from Sergt. Major Sept. 30th 1862. Discharged on Surgeons Cert. Mar. 14th 1863. John was a married man. Badly wounded at Petersburg Va around June 16th 1864. Died in the Harwood Hospital Wash. D.C. 12th July 186 aged 22. Unmarried. Buried in St. Davids Episcopalian Cemetery Manayunk Philadelphia. His brother Henry D. Koche was a soldier in the 28th Pa. (Photo of Joseph and headstone image)

Lafferty Thomas Private Sept 17th 1861 3 Yrs Wounded at Gettysburg

Lewis Richard Pvt This is an ex 71st Pa .soldier probably transferred to the 69th in mass transfer mid 1864. No service details on hand. Assigned to Co K of the 69th. No detail of actual service in the 69th. Died on Jan 13th 1914 Funeral at the Dayton National Military Home Dayton Ohio Jan 16th 1914. Buried Plot 1 15/R10 .@

Lindell John Private Feb.9th 1864 3 Yrs Killed at Petersburg June 22nd 1864.

Lindsay Philip (Co. DUBLIN) Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Discharged on Surgeons Cert Aug 31st 1862. Wife Margaret. Born 1812 Dublin Ireland brother to Thomas Lindsay below. Brother in law to Robert Spence Co. G, Died Philadelphia Sept 4th 1882. Was a weaver by trade. Buried New Cathedral Cemetery Section 5 Range 6 No. 27. He and wife Margaret lived at 520 North 23rd St . Philadelphia. Was a weaver by profession. Joined aged 42.

*** * Lindsay Thomas** (Co. DUBLIN) Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Born Co. Dublin Ireland; Brother to Philip above and brother in law to Robert Spence below.. Fought Gettysburg. Discharged Jan 18th 1864 for wounds received at Gettysburg July 2nd 1863. Wounded left thigh. In The Delaware Co. Republican newspaper June 1st 1866 it was reported that Thomas underwent surgery for apparent bladder stones which in fact turned out be pain caused by a large mini ball which had hit him in the thigh but ended up in his bladder at Gettysburg. On 12th April 1866 a Dr. Forwood performed a very delicate lithotomy operation and removed the said mini ball. Subsequent to this Thomas made a quick and successful recovery. McCormick Stewart Private Oct. 31st 1861 3 Yrs Died at Camp Observation Md. Feb 15th 1862 aged 58. Ceremony at St Pauls church buried Old St Marys cemetery. Philadelphia. @.

McDevitt Hugh Private Oct. 31st 1861 3 Yrs Dishonourably discharged Aug. 1st 1862.

Had lost his left foot after being wounded at Harrisons Landing July 19th 1862 when on patrol after Malvern Hill battle. Hospitalised from July 19th 1862 at Fort Monro then the General Hospital at Newark N.J. until medical discharge Aug 29th 1863. His left leg had to be amputated. In Dec 1882 he is listed as being at the soldiers home in Dayton. He was moved around several soldiers homes in Wash. D.C., Elizabeth City N.J. as well as Dayton Ohio. His mother Ann McMonagle who lived 2141 Montrose St. Philadelphia filed for a pension on Neal after his death on Wash. D.C. 1890. He had worked in the Pension Office as a copyist in Wash D.C from 1887 until his death in 1890. His pay here was \$900 per annum in 1887 and was \$1000 when he died. Neal or Neil died 24th Jan 1890 in Wash D.C. aged 53. He never married. He stated in earlier document that he had been a type caster Buried on Mount Olivet Cemetery .Wash D.C. Plot unknown. @. Note. The spelling of his surname name varies.

Meyers John Private Sept. 25th 1864 3Yrs Born Holland. Draft substitute. Switched from 53rd Pa to the 69th Pa. Died 25th Sept. 1906 Buried Colorado?. (Information may be inaccurate).

Miller John Private Aug 10th 1864 3 Yrs Substitute. Absent sick at muster out.

Miller John F. Private July 13th 1864 3 Yrs Substitute. Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865.

One story suggests that when he died at Andersonville a fellow prisoner that he knew pinned a note on his chest saying who he was. Kind of he was going to be buried at Andersonville but no marker or stone for him there.
