**Asher Asher** Private Aug 19th 1861 3 Yrs Killed battle of Fair Oaks Va June 19th 1862. Member of the Jewish faith. Parents English from London. Buried in the Hebrew Mutual Cemetery Cemetery Lane Philadelphia with other members of his family. He was aged 20 years and 3 month when killed by a gunshot wound to the head while on picket duty before Richmond Va. June 19<sup>TH</sup> 1862. Born 1842. A single man. Buried June 24th 1862. Plot 11B-W. No Marker.

**Attmore Isaac** Private Feb 24th 1864 3 Yrs Captured.6th.May 1864 The Wilderness Va. Died in prison at Florence S.C. Sept 6th 1864.

**Baily Thomas** Private Sept 10th 1864 3 yrs Discharged by G.O. June 9th 1865.

**Ball Henry** Private Aug 19th 1861 3 Yrs Deserted Oct.1861

**Barlow James F.** Private Aug.19th 1861 3 Yrs Absent sick at muster out.

**Barr James** Sergt.Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Prom. Sergt. July 1st 1864.Comm. 2nd Lieut June 16th 1865.Not mustered.

**Baxter Frank T.** Private Aug 19th 1861 3 Yrs Deserted later returned. Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865. Buried in Saint Denis Cemetery Havetown Del Co. Pa.

**Bear Albert** Private July 14th 1861 3 yrs Mustered out July 30th 1864 expiration of term.

**Bolton Henry** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865.

**Bowers James** Private Aug 19th 1861 3 Yrs Wounded with loss of leg at Antietam Sept 17th 1862.Discharged May 15th 1863.

**Boyd Martin** Private April 7th 1864 3 Yrs Not on muster out roll.

**Boyle Jeremiah** Sergt. Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Killed at Gettysburg July 3rd 1863. Buried in the National Cemetery Gettysburg Section D. Grave 8. \probably related to Frank A. Boyle who quote the book "A Party of Mad Fellows" ( See below) as he mentions him in the dedication list on the front of his book.

**Boyle John Francis** Private Aug.19th 1861 3 Yrs Killed at Gettysburg July 3rd 1863 aged 22. . An unmarried man. Buried July 15th. 1863. Buried from 4 Walnut Place below 4th St. Son of Catherine and the late Bernard Boyle. A descendant of this Boyle family one Frank A. Boyle wrote a book on the history of the Irish regiments in the Army of the Potomac called "A Party of Mad Fellows" published

in 1996. Frank lists John Francis in the dedication list on his book. Buried in Old St. Mary's Cemetery Philadelphia. @.

**Bradley John** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Deserted Oct.31st 1862.

**Bradley Patrick** Private Aug.29th 1861 3 Yrs Enlisted aged 18 29th Aug.1861 Philadelphia, mustered in 31st Oct 1861. Not on muster out roll.

**Brady John** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Deserted Aug.28th 1862.

**Brady John** Private April 25th 1864 3 Yrs Discharged by G.O. July 1st 1865.

**Braman George** Private April 2nd 1864 3 Yr Deserted. Returned. Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865.

**Branigan James** Private Aug.19th 1861 3 Yrs Died June 14th 1864 of wounds received at Cold Harbour June 3rd 1864. Buried in National Cemetery Arlington Va. Section 13 grave 6395. James had been court-martialled Feb 1864. Case No. NN-1214. +.

**Breety D.S.** Private Sept.25th 1863 3 yrs Absent sick at muster out.

**Brogan Philip** Private Feb 16th 1864 3 yrs Discharged Dec.12th 1864 for wounds received at Spotsylvania Court House May 12th 1864.

**Bronson Charles** Private Jan 29th 1864.3 Yrs Drafted. Absent sick at muster out.

**Brown Charles** Private Aug 8th 1864 3 Yrs Absent sick at muster out.

**Brown William** (alias Morris Moran) Sergt. April 16th 1864 3 Yrs Prom Sergt Jan 1st 1865. Mustered. Wife Josephine Moran. This alias confirmed by finding grave headstone and death certificate and above alias noted on. Also wives named on headstone. Buried as Morris Moran with wife Josephine in the Woodenridge Cem Detroit Mich. Plot Section A3.

**Buckley Henry V** Private July 1st 1861 3 Yrs Enrolled 1.7.1861 Philadelphia. Mustered in 1.7.1861 at Philadelphia. Enrolled age 23. Promoted Sergt Jan 1st 1865. Had transferred from 71st Regt 12.6.1864 Age 23 at enlistment.

**### Burke Thomas** Born 1855 Ireland Enlisted initially in the 71<sup>st</sup> Pa. Inf. as Private April 2nd 1864 3 Yrs A drafted man . Aged 35 He was 5ft 7ins tall, dark complexion and hair, grey eyes. He transferred into the 69th.12<sup>th</sup> June 1864. He was severely wounded at Reams Station 25<sup>th</sup> Aug 1864. Discharged by Gen Order July 1st 1865. Thomas died 26<sup>th</sup> Jan 1889 and is buried with his wife at St Edwards Cemetery Shamocking Pa. Block 13 Block 23 Plate 1 Lot 81 . @ M

**### Burke Patrick** Corp Aug 19th 1861 3 Yrs Discharged on Surgeons Cert Oct.1st 1862 on orders of General Dix. Had also been reduced in rank. Enrolled aged 32. Died Sept 19<sup>th</sup> 1914, Died in the National Soldiers Home in Elizabeth City aged 77. He had worked as a type caster in the printing trade. He died of lumbar pneumonia. He according to his files also served in the McMullens Ind. Co. Pa Cavalry. Buried Hampton National Cemetery Hampton City Va. Plot section A site 10638.@ M

**Byrn Michael** Private Mar.31st 1864 3 Yrs Not on muster out roll.

**Callahan James** Corp. April 13th 1864. 3 Yrs Prom. to Corp March 1st 1865. Musterd out with Co. July 1st 1865.

**Cameron Frank W.** Private Aug 19th 1861 3 Yrs Deserted Oct. 1861.

**Cammel Joseph** Private Feb.3rd 1861 3 Yrs Not on muster out roll.

**Campbell James** Corp Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Deserted may 3rd 1862.

**Campbell W. Sylvester** Private Aug.19th 1861 3 Yrs Mustered out Nov 12th 1864

expiration of term. Born c1845. His health had failed and he ended up in the V.R.C. Later a salesman in Philadelphia but died there of consumption 4<sup>th</sup> Aug 1878. Buried in the New Cathedral Cemetery Philadelphia Section J. Lot D. Grave 11. He was aged 33 and a single man. Lived at 2024 Catherine St. Born Philadelphia 1845. Supposed to be buried under a Government headstone/marker./@

**Carroll Thomas** 2nd Lieut Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Went absent from the Bolivar Heights area without leave. Did not return .He would appear to have taken a terminal illness and died at Philadelphia June 25th 1862.

**Carted Charles** Private Aug.19th 1861 3 Yrs Deserted Oct.5th 1861

\* \* **Cassidy John** (Co. MAYO) Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Died aged 23 of wounds received at Gettysburg July 3rd 1863. Buried in the Old Cathedral Cem. Philadelphia Photo exists. Born Co. Mayo.

**Cavanaugh James** Private July 2nd 1861 3 Yrs Absent sick at muster out.

**Chandler William J.** Private Aug 19th 1861 3 Yrs Deserted Jan 21 returned Nov 4th 1863. Mustered out June 17th 1865.

**Clark Andrew** Private Aug.8th 1864 3 Yrs Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865.

**Clark John W.** Private Sept 24th 1863 3 Yrs Absent wounded at muster out.

### **Cloney Thomas J.** Private Aug.19th 1861 3 Yrs Captured at Antietam Sept 17th 1862. Deserted July 21st 1863. Returned. Wounded at Spotsylvania Court House May 12th 1864. Also captured Antietam and Scots Ford near Fredericksburg during the Chancellorsville campaign. Mustered out Sept 26th 1864 expiration of term. Buried New Cathedral Cemetery Plot Section J Range 9 Lot 42 Had died Sept 21<sup>st</sup> 1874.@

**Collins Bernard** Private Aug.19th 1861 3 Yrs Mustered out Aug 27th 1864 expiration of term. Born 1845. Died Philadelphia Dec 4<sup>th</sup> 1891. Probably buried in communal grave at Holy Cross cemetery Yeadon Pa. Was initially buried St Marys Cemetery Philadelphia (defunct).

**Condren Edward** Private Sept 25th 1863 3 Yrs Drafted. Discharged on Surgeons Cert. Jan. 2nd 1865

**Conlin Felix** Private Aug. 19th 1861 3 Yrs at Philadelphia aged 29. Light complexion, height 5ft 4ins, grey eyes light hair Born Philadelphia. Deserted 4<sup>th</sup> Jan 1863.

\* \* **Connor Peter** (Co. TYRON) Private Sept 3rd 1862 3 yrs Born Co. Tyrone Discharged by G.O. June 9th 1865. Some historians list as belonging to a Co. H.

**Corcoran Michael** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Deserted June 3rd 1862.

**Cullin James** Private Aug 19th 1861 3 Yrs Deserted Oct.1861

**Cuppeck Richard** Private Aug.19th 1861 3 Yrs Deserted Oct.1861.

**Cush William** Private Aug 19th 1861 3 Yrs Discharged Sept 27 for wounds received at Antietam Sept.17th 1862.

**Davis Littleton Thomas** Sergt. Aug.19th 1861 3 yrs Wounded at Petersburg June 16th 1864. Prom. from Corp Oct.25th 1865. Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865. Had also served in Co I of the 18<sup>th</sup> Pa, Inf. Born 1843 died Mar 28<sup>th</sup> 1889. Buried Evergreen Cemetery Camden N.J..

**Degan Francis M.** Private July 1st 1861 3 Yrs Mustered out Aug 5th 1864

**Deichler George Philip** 1st Lieut Aug.29th 1861 3 Yrs Enrolled aged 21 into Co. I. He was machinist from Lancaster Pa. Probably of German stock. Born Lancaster Pa. 1836. Wounded at Gettysburg and spent months in hospital. Recovered and rejoined the regiment. Prom. to Corp Feb 1st 1862, to Sergt Aug 27th 1864, to 1st Lieut March 16th 1865. Wounded again at Reams Station Aug. 25th 1864 and again spent time in hospital and again after recovering rejoined regiment but was again badly wounded at Hatcher's Run Mar 25th 1865. He was hospitalised to the Armory Square Hospital in Wash D.C. 1st April 1865. He was medically discharged on Aug 10th 1865 with a pension of \$17 a month and sent home. He later went to live in Indianapolis and married a divorced lady called Annie McDougal but this did not work out and he returned to Lancaster Co. He never recovered from his wounds and also probably suffered from P.T.S.D post traumatic stress disorder as known as now. He was never able to hold down any job however trivial. He died aged 59. Deichler was a very good example of so many of the soldiers of the Civil War whose lives were destroyed by their wounds and experiences. So many others would have suffered the same fate. In Deichler we have some documented proof. (Photo) He died in Philadelphia aged 59 in the Episcopal Hospital from pneumonia 24<sup>th</sup> Feb 1895. However though his death certificate indicated "buried Lancaster" it is not known exactly which cemetery. There is a Deichler family grave in the Woodward Hill Cemetery but no grave markers naming George can be found in the group. On his death cert the undertaker would appear to have taken his remains directly from the hospital to his own premises. Suggests he possibly used a Potters Field grave for his remains?. No proof either way. However his father did not die until 1903 so its unlikely he would not have insisted his son be in a proper grave as he had died 24.Feb.1895. Here is a short biography by historian Scott Hartwig. Acknowledged with thanks.

*Lieutenant George P. Deichler served during the Civil War in Company I, 69th Pennsylvania Infantry. He also served in Co.H 24th Pennsylvania Infantry. "Among the non-commissioned officers who supervised the movement of Company I from the wall was Corporal George P. Deichler, a 24-year old machinist from Lancaster, Pennsylvania, where he lived with his father, Philip. During the action, a Virginian's bullet hit Deichler in the left groin. This serious and very painful wound laid the corporal up for many months. He recovered though, and returned to his regiment only to be wounded again at Ream's Station, on August 25, 1864, where a shell fragment struck him in the head and a minnie ball hit his knee. Though he spent nearly six months in convalescence, Deichler was tough, and he returned to the regiment in March, 1865, and was promoted to 1st Lieutenant. Nine days after his promotion, on March 25, 1865, at the 2nd Battle of Hatcher's Run, a Confederate bullet hit Deichler in the lower part of the stomach and blew a hole in his back. Deichler's captain, Joseph Garrett, wrote of the wound; "I considered it serious as the fluids and other matter was coming out from the Bowels." This, Deichler's fourth wound, finished his soldiering, though somehow his iron constitution pulled him through and he survived it. He received his discharge and was pensioned at \$17 a month beginning August 10, 1865.*

*Sometime after his discharge Deichler moved to Indianapolis. He met Annie E. McDougal there. She had recently divorced her first husband, and on July 26, 1875, John G. Smith, a Minister of the Gospel, married Annie and George. But the marriage that began with high hopes unraveled over the next six years. George's Gettysburg wound in the groin may have had something to do with the problems the couple experienced. He also drank heavily, probably to ease the constant pain that assailed his body from his four wounds. To make ends meet, Annie had to take in boarders, and find whatever other work she could. It was not enough. On June 4, 1881, Deichler left his wife and returned to Lancaster to live with his father. There was no divorce, Deichler simply left One year later, Deichler sought employment with Davis Kitch, who had the contract with the city of Lancaster to light the city street lights. He started on July 1, 1882, but had to quit several days later, "as he was unable to stand the fatigue of walking and the exertion incident to such employment." In an affidavit, Kitch stated that he "does not know of any lighter or easier employment than lighting lamps and he [Deichler] is utterly unfitted for that work." Deichler described his tortured life in a statement accompanying his claim For a pension increase in Dec 1888.*

*I'm nervous have continual pain inside of body my wounds of knee and groin pain me. Can not hold my water any more, it depresses (?) me. Had an operation three years ago, [unintelligible words]. No sexual desire any more. Never had children. Never sick during war. Have been laid up last year from pains and nervous. Deichler's request for increase was denied. He continued to request increases regularly, but each one was denied. In 1894 the examining surgeon wrote that Deichler, "seems demented & melancholic," and that he was a "pale, tremulous man" with a "mind enfeebled." Five years later, on February 24, at age 60, Deichler died of pneumonia. That he lived as long as he did is remarkable, but the Confederate bullet at Gettysburg and his subsequent wounds left him a broken, unhappy, and lonely man, and slowly sapped his life from him." Buried Woodward Hill Cemetery Philadelphia,*

**### Delahide Martin (Dolehide)** Born Ireland.1843 Enlisted as Private Aug 19th 1861 3 Yrs Discharged Jan 29th 1863 for wounds received near Richmond June 19th 1862.Antietam. Buried in Holy Cross cemetery Yeadon Pa. along with wife Mary who died aged 46 5<sup>th</sup> April 1891. Funeral from 510 Metcalf St. She was buried from St Philips Church to the Holy Cross Cemetery Yeadon Pa. She would appear to have pre-deceased her husband. Mary died 5<sup>th</sup> April 1891 aged 46. Residence 510 Metcalf St.

**Dever James** (noted on Pa cards as 2<sup>nd</sup>) .Private 2<sup>nd</sup> Sept 1861. M.I. 31<sup>st</sup> 1861 3 Yrs Deserted Alexandria Va 28<sup>th</sup> March 1862

**Devine James** Private Oct.31at 1861 3 Yrs Killed at Charles City Cross Roads Va. June 30th 1862.

**### Devine Thomas** Sergt.Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Ireland: Killed at Spotsylvania Court House May 12th 1864.

**Dilley Samuel K.** Corp May 21st 1861 3 Yrs Prom. Corporal Jan 1st 1865. Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865.

**Diver Thomas C.** Private Aug.19th 1861 3 Yrs Aged 20 the only child of Jane

Diver a widow. Thomas was a printer before the war. He sent the greater percentage of his army pay back to his mother. In May 1863 he writes his mother " Dear Mother, I think that this will not last longer than this summer and even if it does I have only got 15 months to stay and that will slide around quicker than the 21 months that I have been away". Sadly a few months later at Gettysburg during Picketts charge towards the center of the Union line by Gen. Armitage on July 3rd 1863 he would be killed. He is buried in the Evergreen Cemetery Gettysburg. Initially buried at George Hertings farm but later re-interred to Evergreen Cem. At Gettysburg. Killed by head wound.

**Dolan James** Private Sept 6th 1862 3 Yrs Deserted July 14th 1863.

**Donahue Henry** Corp Oct.31st 1861 3 yrs Deserted March 28th 1862.

**Donovan Jeremiah** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Discharged on Surgeons Cert Feb.22nd 1863.

**Dougherty John** Private Feb 3rd 1865 3 Yrs Discharged on G.O.July 1st 1865.

**Dougherty Neal** Private Oct.31st 1861 3 Yrs Deserted Feb.26th 1862 at Adamtown Md. Had enrolled aged 23.Height 5ft 9ins, blue eyes red hair sandy complexion. A labourer by trade. Also known as Neil Dougherty.

**\* \* Duffy Michael** ( Abbert Co. Galway ). Mustered in 19<sup>th</sup> Jan 1861 3 Yrs Prom. from 1st Sergt to 2nd Lieut. March 1st 1862 then to 1st Lieut Nov.1st 1862 then Capt. May 1st 1863. Killed at Gettysburg July 2nd 1863 on Cemetery Hill Gettysburg .1sr. Lieut William McNamara took command. Duffy subsequently Buried Old Cathedral Cem. Philadelphia. Section G Range 5 Lot 14.

**Dugan William** Private Mar 31st 1864 3 Yrs Died at City Point June 27th of wounds received at Petersburg Va June 25th 1864.Buried at City Point Cemetery Hopewell Va. Grave 343.

**Dunlevy Henry** Corp Feb 27th 1864 3 Yrs Prom. Corporal Jan 1st 1865.Mustered out with Co. July 1st 1865.

**Dupell William** Private Aug 19th 1861 3 Yrs Born 1843. Died at Yorktown Va May 21st 1862 from typhoid. Buried in the Yorktown National Cemetery Yorktown Pa. Plot 1019. Dupell was a prolific letter writer and sent many letters back to his mother on the day to day existence of the men of the 69<sup>th</sup>. Died of typhoid in Yorktown Hospital 21<sup>st</sup> May 1862.+.

**Echard George** Private Aug.19th 1861 3 Yrs Deserted Oct.5th 1861

**Ecker Charles** Drafter soldier From Lucerne Co. Pa. Private Sept 17th 1863 3 Yrs Badly wounded at Reams Station Aug. 24th 1864. Died 6.Oct.1864. Buried at City Point Cemetery Hopewell Va. Grave No. E 556. Was absent at muster out. +.

**Eckhardt Benjamin F.** Private Aug 19th 1861 3 Yrs Deserted Oct.1861

**Elben William Turpin** Corp Aug 19th 1861 3 Yrs Captured at Antietam Sept 17th 1862 . Prom. to Corporal April 15th 1864. Fought at Gettysburg Captured June 22nd 1864 Jerusalem Plank Road. Taken Andersonville and survived. Discharged by G.O. May 17th 1865. (Photo) Buried with wife in the Spring Hill Cemetery Easton Maryland. Born Sept 12th 1812. Died March 29th 1914. (Marker Image) (Photo Image).Was married twice, Firstly to Mary Ann Husted in 1860/61 in N.J. and secondly to Georgina Mann in Galena East Shore Md. William lived in various places Galena Kent Co. Md. In Talbot Co, Md. Baltimore City Md. East Talbot Co.

Md. William was born 12.9.1842 in N.J. according to census of 1860. The Elben family were of German lineage. Was a tentmate of Pines .See below.

**Ellis John** Private Mar 30th 1864 3 Yrs Discharged by G.O. June 9th 1865

**Ellison John P.** Private Aug 9th 1861. 3 Yrs Wounded at Gettysburg July 3rd 1863. Mustered out Aug 27th 1864 expiration of term.

**Elmer Amos** Private. April 20th 1864 3 Yrs. Wounded in action June 18th 1864 Petersburg. Absent at muster out. Born March 1844 Died May 1902. Buried Old Tennent Churchyard Tennent Mont Co. N.J. (Marker Image). Note marker has Co C inscribed on it.

**Etter George** Private Aug 19th 1861 3 Yrs aged 20 Born 12<sup>th</sup> Aug 1842 in Philadelphia. Died 16<sup>th</sup> May 1914 aged 71 in Philadelphia. A jeweller by trade. Hwould appear to have deserted three times as per his records. Deserted initially Oct. 1861 from Poolesville. Then deserted Fair Oaks Va. June June 28<sup>th</sup> 1862 and apprehended July 3<sup>rd</sup> 1863 and placed in hospital. Several days later on July 5<sup>th</sup> 1862 he again deserted and dropped from rolls. Hthen returned and reported for duty April 29<sup>th</sup> 1863 but was placed under the control of Philadelphia provost guard and was reported as a deserter. However this record was changed by the Adj. General on March 23<sup>rd</sup> 1864 and he was placed in the 21<sup>st</sup> Vet Corps. It way well be that this man suffered from mental health problems hence intervention by Adj General. Buried Norwood Cemetery Philadelphia. M..

**Farrell Joseph** Private Oct 31st 1861 3 Yrs Deserted July 10th 1862.

**Farrell Thomas** Sergt. Oct 31st 1861 3 Yrs Deserted June 5th 1862.

**Finnell John** Private Oct 31st 1861 3 Yrs Deserted April 16th 1862.

**Fitzgerald Patrick** Private Oct.16th 1861 3 Yrs . Born 1836 in Cambridge Mass . Died Aug 13 1913 Everett Mass. Apart from the 69<sup>th</sup> Pa. Patrick served in Co G of the 5<sup>th</sup> U.S. Inf. Co H of the 37<sup>th</sup> U.S. Inf.. Battery I 1<sup>st</sup> U.S. Cav. and Kirbys 1<sup>st</sup> U.S. Art. To which he had been transferred to 25<sup>th</sup> Oct. 1862. Buried Glenwood Cemetery Everett Middsex Co. Mass. Greenlawn section.

**Fitzsimmons John** Enlisted as private Aug.19th 1861 3 Yrs at Philadelphia 19<sup>th</sup> Aug 1861 aged 19. Died at Newark N.J. from fever 21<sup>st</sup>. Oct 1862. Buried Holy Sepulchre Cemetery East Orange Essex Co. N.J. Buried Soldiers Plot 46- 1.

**### Flynn Thomas** Private April 15th 1863 3 Yrs Ireland: Mustered out with Co.July 1st 1865.

**Frazer John** Private Jan 9th 1863 3 Yrs Deserted June 14th 1863.

**Frazier William M.** Private Aug.19th 1861 3 Yrs Aged 32. Born Pa. 1820. Active service 31<sup>st</sup> Oct 1861 to July 1<sup>st</sup> 1865. Fought at the Wall at Gettysburg. Survived the war and mustered out 1st July 1865.. Of dark complexion grey eyes and was a groomsmen by trade. .Died June 18<sup>th</sup> 1880 at West Deptford Gloucester Co. N.J. Buried in the Old Depford Strangers Burial Ground 97 Caulfield Ave. Depford Gloucester Co. N.J. To claim his amnesty which was granted. However he never did get a pension. Born Philadelphia and a painter by trade. Joined as a musician but was quickly transferred to become a private soldier. Discharged by G.O. June 2<sup>nd</sup> 1865. Died Feb 4<sup>th</sup> 1874 and was buried in the now defunct Machpelah Cemetery. Remains from this cemetery appear to have been taken to Mount Moriah cemetery.

A note in the Pa Civil War card system says he was taken prisoner at Petersburg 22<sup>nd</sup> June 1864 but was released on the orders of Major Havden. However a few years later Francis joined the 6<sup>th</sup> U.S Cavalry unit recruiting in Philadelphia for service in the West and enlisted in the regiment. He would appear to have served at Fort Whipple in the Arizona Territory. He was enlisted Aug 3<sup>rd</sup> 1872 by Capt. Whiteside. He is noted in his records as being aged 29 and a printer He was 5ft 6ins tall, grey eyes, dark hair fair complexion. He served in the West probably mostly in Arizona Territory until he was discharged at Fort Whipple A.T. June 9<sup>th</sup> 1877. He is noted on his discharge papers as being Sergeant rank and in character excellent. It would

appear he went back home to Philadelphia .Died in Philadelphia March 13<sup>th</sup> 1907 aged 62, He was born Nov 25<sup>th</sup> 1844. He is buried in the Holy Cross Cemetery Yeadon Pa. in grave position 14.1.52.Andersonsville records record a Francis McClarren or McClavant captured at Petersburg 22<sup>nd</sup> June 1864 and later exchanged and discharged Jan 8<sup>th</sup> 1865 . He would appear to be the brother of James McCarren below as both died at 1929 Hamilton St. Philadelphia. He was a widower at his death. He had worked as a clerk. Fathers name Daniel mother Sarah.

James was initially buried in the St. Marys Cemetery and this was made his remains to Holy Cross Cemetery Yeadon. Probably mass grave. A small man 5ft 4 1/2ins dark complexion hazel eyes. Gave his trade as carpenter when he enlisted.

the U.S. Marines at Philadelphia as a private and was discharged 4<sup>th</sup>. May 1892 at Wash. D. C. a period of approx. 5 years. He had enlisted in the Marines aged 38 which seems quite an advanced age! Amongst Simons assignment records is one dated late 1887 when a muster roll on the U.S. Naval sloop "Jamestown". Simon McDermott is listed as being in a detachment of about 30 Marines on board and the detachment under the command of 1<sup>st</sup>. Lieut J. R. Benson. This muster roll taken at the Navy Yard Norfolk Va. NOTE. The "Jamestown" a Naval sloop played a fairly major part in the sinking of quite a few Confederate ships during the Civil War in American waters and also at a time served in the Pacific area in anti Confederacy shipping supply chains. Simon would appear to have developed poor health towards the end of his service according to his records he was discharged April 25<sup>th</sup> 1892 in poor health. In his records aged 53 he is listed as still being a brass finisher was living in Chicago Ill and was a married man his wife Margaret and they living at 405 W. Adams St. Chicago. This would have been circa 1902. Gave his faith as Catholic. Died 1940 aged 91. He had fair complexion height 5ft 3 3/4", brown eyes, dark hair and was a brass finisher by trade. He is then found in the Philadelphia 1930 census as aged 79. He had come back home to Philadelphia.. Simon died Oct 14<sup>th</sup> 1940 in Milwaukee Wisc. Old Soldiers home. Buried Wood National Cemetery Milwaukee Wisc. Plot 51- 0 - 39A. @ M.

Had been wounded at Fredericksburg Dec.13th 1862. Discharged Aug 20th 1864. Born Cork in 1843. Died Philadelphia 26.4.1909. Had also served in Co. G 2<sup>nd</sup>. Pa. Inf and Co G 19<sup>th</sup> Pa. Inf. Buried Holy Cross Cem. Yeadon Pa. Buried with wife Mary Mullen McNamara. Buried Section Y Range 2 Lot 53. Extender family plot with two markers. See bio on him.

Took home his musket and bayonet for which he was charged \$19.25 and given transportation back to Philadelphia Aug. 23<sup>rd</sup> 1864. Filed for a pension Nov. 18<sup>th</sup>. 1869. He then joined the new 1<sup>st</sup> Del Regt as a sergeant. He was quickly promoted to Sergt Major in Jan 1862 and then 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieut in April of the same year. The regiment were engaged in many battles with the Confederates and as a result of his actions at the battle of Antietam he would later in Dec 1899 receive his M.O.H. for his past bravery. On Sept 13<sup>th</sup> 1863 he was medically discharged from the army. However on Oct. 24<sup>th</sup> 1864 he again enlisted this time in Co. H of the 69<sup>th</sup> Pa. Inf. As a 1<sup>st</sup> Lieut. He was again wounded in the knee at the battle of Petersburg Va. He was discharged from the 69<sup>th</sup> Pa on May 25<sup>th</sup> 1865. He married after the war and had a daughter and was a postmaster at Kennett Sq . Pa. He later moved to Wash D.C.and was a clerk in the War Dept. He died Dec 13<sup>th</sup> 1911 and is buried with his wife and daughter in Greenfield cemetery Hempstead Long Island New York. A tall man of 5ft 11ins dark complexion, brown hair and hazel eyes.

**Teaver Peter** Private Sept 26th 1863 3 Yrs Drafted. Discharged on Surgeons Cert. Jan 11th 1865.

**Thatcher Oliver** Private Aug 19th 1861 3 Yrs Deserted Oct 116th 1863.

Mustered out Aug 27<sup>th</sup> 1864 expiration of term. William wrote a letter to his parents Nov 20<sup>th</sup> 1861 from Monocacy Md saying "It is hard to get French Leave because there are patrols on every road around the camp and many have deserted due to lack of whiskey". William wrote numerous letters perhaps around 60 to his parents. These letters still exist and are held by the Philadelphia Archdiocese Historical Research Center. William survived the war. He had fought at the Wall at Gettysburg. Dates of his age vary in various documents but a birth date of 1843 and death date of Jan 7<sup>th</sup> 1893 thought to be fairly accurate. Death cert states he aged 40 when he died. A labourer by trade. He never married. He is buried in the Old Cathedral cemetery Philadelphia Section A range 8 lot 51-52 east margin in 51.@.
